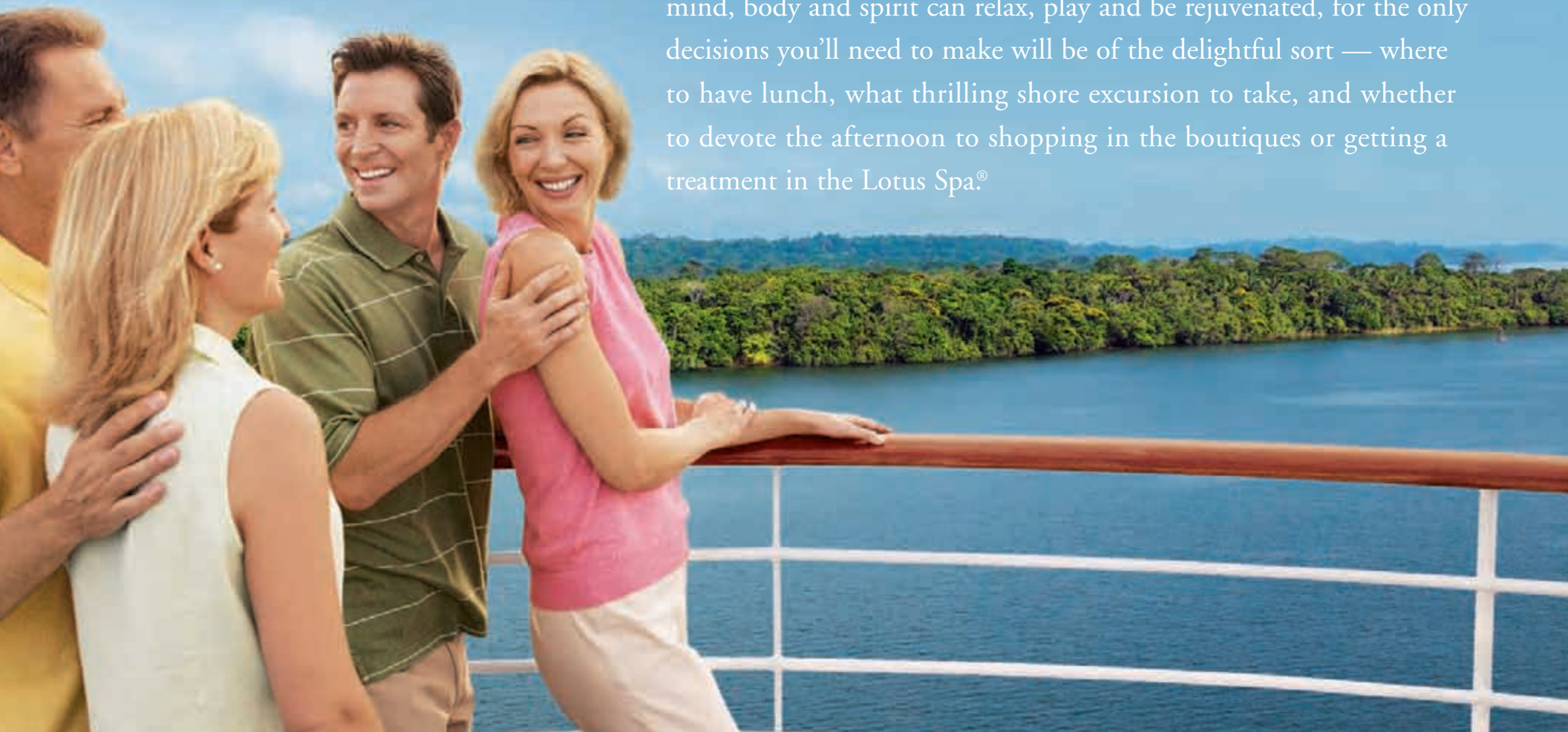

Canal construction begins, 1904



## *An army of men move the earth and a dream is realized*

It began in earnest on May 4, 1904 with a simple ceremony and the passing of a set of keys. The French had already tried and failed — sinking nearly \$300 million in fewer than 10 miles of canal — when they handed over authority of Panama Canal construction to the United States. Ten years later, on August 15, 1914, a cement boat called the S.S. Ancon, piloted by Captain John A. Constantine, made the first official transit through a route that had been dreamed of for over 400 years. The Panama Canal was operational. And has remained so to this day.

For almost a century, an average of 40 ships a day have crossed the Isthmus of Panama, sailing through the massive locks of the Canal from ocean to ocean in about eight hours — cutting thousands of miles and weeks of travel from their itineraries. Now you too can experience this fabled journey. Except that you'll do it on ships custom-built for the transit. Let your imagination transport you back in time, to an era before computers or jet planes, to a time when a dream was enough to achieve the impossible. And become part of the history of the Panama Canal.



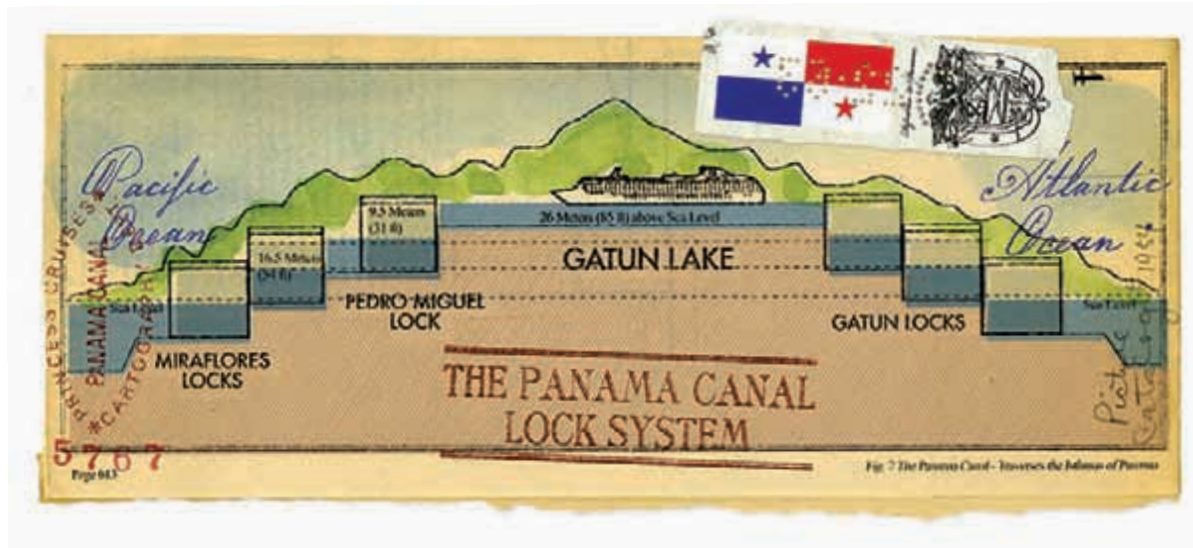

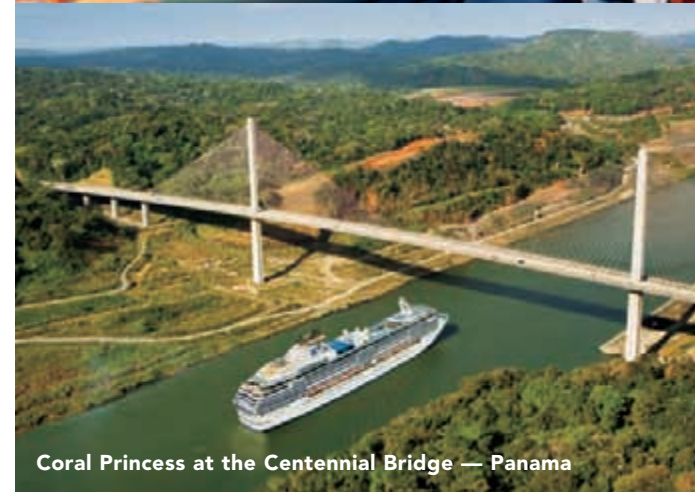

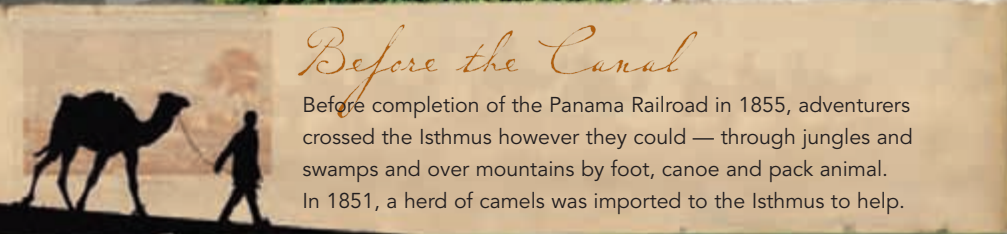

A convenient chart of "high-low temperatures" by destination will help you figure out just the right items to pack. Of course, it's always a good idea to bring layers of clothing — perfect for any unexpected change in temperature. It's usually helpful to take along sunglasses and sunscreen for walking on deck, as well as a swimsuit for dipping into our onboard pools — no matter whether you're going to a warm or cool climate. For destinations noted for their precipitation, it's important to include an umbrella or extra windbreaker.

## BOUTIQUES ONBOARD

Treasures await your browsing eye in the Boutiques Onboard. So be sure to leave plenty of room in your luggage for purchases you make in our duty-free shipboard boutiques. Princess offers a 5-year guarantee for merchandise.

## SHOPPING ASHORE

If you want to shop on shore, check the port maps for a list of suggested stores. Any bargainer worth his or her salt will love this on shore luxury. There's a shopper's guarantee for registered purchases at recommended stores.

## HOW DO I RESERVE SHORE TOURS?

You'll enjoy a choice of guided tours in every port of call, each highlighting great places to sightsee, shop and experience local culture. For your convenience, tours may be reserved 120 days in advance on a first-come, first-served basis, or they can be purchased onboard based on availability. You can reserve your tours online by going to [princess.com](http://princess.com) and selecting the Cruise Personalizer.® Please note that space is limited on some tours. Tour descriptions are available online and in the Adventures Ashore® brochure, which is provided to you in your Pre-Cruise Information Packet prior to your cruise departure. Onboard, the ship's shore excursion staff can also answer any other questions you may have and help you with additional arrangements. Shore Excursions are operated by local, independent companies, not by Princess, and Princess gets a commission on all tours sold.

## WHAT TO BRING

**What should I wear on the ship?** You should dress for cruising the same way you would for any stylish land-based resort. Casual sportswear, including shorts, lightweight pants, and jogging suits are the order of the day both at sea and on shore in hotter climates. Just remember to bring a sweater or jacket for cool evenings.

For evening dining, there are two designations for dress codes in our dining rooms: Smart Casual and Formal. When evening dress is Smart Casual, passengers dress as they would for a fine restaurant at home. Appropriate attire includes skirts/dresses, slacks, and sweaters or blouses for ladies and pants and open-neck shirts for men. In the dining room, items such as cutoff T-shirts and halter tops are not permitted, and shoes must be worn at all times. On formal nights, appropriate attire includes evening gowns and cocktail dresses for ladies, and tuxedos, slacks with dinner jackets, or suits for men. Princess offers formal wear rental on all itineraries and this can be arranged prior to your cruise.

For shore excursions, you'll want to bring a sweater, a light jacket, or an all-weather coat, depending on your destination. Due to unpredictable weather, don't forget a hat or visor and a collapsible umbrella. Please be sure to wear proper clothing for visits to religious sites. You'll also want low-heeled, rubber-soled shoes for strolling on deck, as well as comfortable walking shoes or sandals to wear while exploring ashore.

**What documents do I bring?** You'll need your cruise Boarding Pass or Travel Summary, and airline tickets or airline eTicket receipt. In addition, you should bring with you a copy of the Cruise Passage Contract. All passengers, including children, must travel with a passport, valid for at least six months from the end of the cruise. You must also present vaccination certificates and other health documents if required for your particular ports of call. If you

don't have the proper documentation, you will be prevented from boarding the flight or vessel without refund of the cruise fare and/or airfare, and you will be subject to any fine or other costs incurred by Princess. Please consult your travel agent for full details regarding documentation, as it is your obligation to determine what documents will be necessary. Remember your medical insurance ID card and travel insurance information as well. If you are traveling with children, please refer to the "Children" section under General Information for additional document requirements.

**What about hair dryers, electric razors and laundry?** For your convenience, Princess provides hair dryers in every stateroom and laundromats for self-service washing and ironing. All ships feature outlets for electric razors, and for a fee, laundry services are also available.

## TAKING CARE OF BUSINESS

**What does the price include?** Your comprehensive cruise fare includes onboard accommodations, ocean transportation, meals, some nonalcoholic beverages and most entertainment. Excluded are meals at some alternative dining venues, meals on hosted land tours unless noted otherwise, transfers and items of a personal nature such as, but not limited to, spa services, shore excursions, beverages and some snacks, photographs, gratuities, discretionary hotel and dining charges and medical services.

**Do I need cash on my vacation?** Yet another convenience of cruising with Princess is being able to sign for all of your shipboard expenses, excluding stamps. Casino chips, slot tokens and bingo cards can also be obtained on a casino room charge (for a nominal fee). You'll receive an itemized list of all charges the night before disembarkation and you can wait until the day of disembarkation to settle your account.

We accept Visa, MasterCard, Discover Card, Diners Club, Carte Blanche and American Express/Optima. U.S. currency, Canadian currency, British currency, Euro currency, personal checks for limited amounts, and traveler's checks are also accepted. Those paying by traveler's checks or cash will be required to leave a \$300 USD per person cash deposit with the Purser's staff at the beginning of the cruise. Cruisetour passengers will find that traveler's checks and major credit cards are widely accepted in most ports of call.

**When will I receive my documents?** Only Princess eTickets offers you the freedom and flexibility to access your booking details any time you want. Upon confirmation of your booking, you can use the Cruise Personalizer at [princess.com](http://princess.com) to view your reservation, add or update your required Pre-Cruise Immigration Form (PIF) information, download required forms, and view and print a Boarding Pass and Travel Summary. At approximately 120 days prior to the voyage departure date, via the Cruise Personalizer, you will have access to view and reserve the shore excursions offered and book Lotus Spa® appointments available on your voyage.

To further help you plan for your vacation, upon full payment, Princess will send a Pre-Cruise Information Packet approximately 75 days prior to departure. This Princess-exclusive packet includes a letter detailing how you can prepare for your cruise, a Cruise Answer Book, Adventures Ashore brochure, Passage Contract and luggage tags. Simply follow the Pre-Cruise Checklist in the Cruise Answer Book, access the Cruise Personalizer,® enter the mandatory immigration information, and you will be able to print your Boarding Pass. Cruise tickets are no longer issued by Princess. Also at this time you will be able to view air details if purchased through Princess. Any additional documents such as airline eTicket receipts or paper air tickets, etc., may be sent via fax, mail or email to your travel agent approximately 14 days prior to departure. If you do not have Internet access, your travel agent may assist you in securing the necessary information or call 1-800-PRINCESS (800-774-6237) for assistance.

**Do you provide Express Check-Out?** Like the finest hotels, Princess offers a quick and easy check-out service onboard. Just bring your credit card or personal check and identification to the Passenger Services/Purser's Desk as early as possible during your cruise.

**What is the discretionary Hotel and Dining charge?** During your cruise, you will meet many members of our staff in a variety of locations as they provide you with impeccable service. Additionally, many more crew behind the scenes support those who serve you directly. To save you the worry of who to tip and how much, Princess makes it easier for you to reward excellent service by automatically adding a discretionary Hotel and Dining charge of \$11 USD for suites and mini-suites, and \$10.50 USD for all other staterooms per passenger per day (including children) to your shipboard account. The Hotel and Dining charge will be shared



amongst those staff who help provide and support your cruise experience, including the waitstaff, stateroom stewards and housekeeping staff, buffet stewards, food production staff, galley staff and others. (Casino dealers and Lotus Spa personnel do not share in the Hotel and Dining charge as not all passengers utilize these services).

**What is the Bar and Wine charge?** A 15% charge is automatically added to your bar charges and dining room wine account. This is shared amongst the beverage staff and their support staff, including cleaners and utility staff.

**Do you offer travel insurance?** We strongly recommend the purchase of Princess Travel Care<sup>SM</sup> travel protection, which covers up to the full value of your trip in case you need to cancel or interrupt your trip. There will be no refund of cancellation or interruption fees by Princess. You must recover such fees from Princess Travel Care or other travel protection. For a full description of this program, please refer to the Travel Care section of this brochure. Additionally, you will want to reference the Princess Travel Care information pamphlet for a full listing of the coverage provided. Please contact your travel agent for current rates.

**How do I make arrangements for dining room seating and special diets?** Seating arrangements in the dining room are made by request on a first-come, first-served basis. To request Anytime Dining<sup>SM</sup> Traditional first or second seating, special diets, or seating with a specific party, it is best to have your travel agent request your arrangements at the time of booking. Your dining arrangements will be shown on your cruise ticket.

**What about clearing customs?** At the end of your cruise, customs and immigration inspectors will review your customs declaration form, on which you are to list all of the dutiable articles bought in foreign ports or in the ship's boutique. U.S. residents returning to the United States are allowed a duty-free exemption of \$800 USD per person, which includes the cost of one liter of alcoholic beverages, if purchased ashore, for each passenger over 21 years of age. Canadian citizens, when out of the country for more than eight days, may bring back up to \$750 CAD duty-free. It is recommended that passengers keep their sales receipts handy for declaring their purchases. Food items should not be landed in U.S. ports.

#### EXTRA SERVICES

**What about celebrations at sea?** When you cruise with Princess, every day is a celebration. But if you're planning to travel during an anniversary, birthday, honeymoon or other

specific event, you can rely on us to pull out all the stops. Simply have your travel agent advise us of such occasions at least three weeks prior to departure, and we'll be happy to spotlight your event in the dining room or with special packages (some charges may apply).

#### Do you have a Youth and Teen Program?

Youth and teens are welcome on all Princess ships, but facilities vary. Our fully supervised Youth and Teen Centers are available for children and teens ages 3-17 onboard Caribbean, Coral, Crown, Dawn, Diamond, Emerald, Golden, Grand, Island, Sun, Sapphire and Star Princess, and they offer everything from arts & crafts and talent shows, to video games and dance parties. Sea Princess has a Youth Center and runs programs with counselors for kids and teens ages 3-17, but has no dedicated Teen Center. Youth and Teen Programs are available on Pacific, Tahitian and Royal Princess when at least 20 passengers ages 3-17 are sailing.

Children with special needs are welcome in the Youth & Teen Centers.

Youth staff are not able to provide one-on-one supervision and cannot administer medication, change diapers, bottle feed or provide meal service (except on port days when supervised lunch is offered). Youth and teen facilities will operate every day.

**Are there babysitters onboard?** Although private babysitting is not available on any ship, group kidsitting is available for children ages 3-12 between the hours of 10 p.m.-1 a.m. in the Youth Center. The charge is \$5 USD per hour, per child. Complimentary supervised activities are available in port from 8 a.m.-5 p.m. for youth passengers ages 3-17. Due to limited facilities, group kidsitting is not available on Pacific, Tahitian and Royal Princess.

**What age groups are serviced by the Youth and Teen Program?** The program generally is as follows: Princess Pelicans activities are for children ages 3-7; Shockwaves activities are for youths ages 8-12; Remix activities are for teens ages 13-17. Children under the age of 3 are welcome to visit the Youth Center if supervised by a parent at all times. Parents should be advised that each program features specialized age-specific programming and registered youth passengers can only participate in the program designated for their age.

**How can I be reached at sea?** To provide greater peace of mind while you're away from home, give friends and relatives the following information on how to telephone you. Call 1-900-329-SHIP from the United States or 1-900-565-2800 from Canada. Note that 900-

number telephone services are not available from all areas, and may not be accessible on your home phone. For calls originating outside the United States or Canada, please visit [princess.com/answer/ready.html](http://princess.com/answer/ready.html) for dialing instructions. Calls can also be charged to a credit card in both the United States and Canada by dialing 1-877-656-7447. Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Discover Card (not Canadian) are all accepted. The cost for each call is \$8.95 USD per minute or \$11.95 CAD per minute. The 900 service can be used to call or fax the ship. Please include passenger name and cabin number to ensure quick delivery.

#### SAFETY FIRST

Many of our Captains and officers come from long, seagoing family traditions, tracing generations of sailors up to 200 years back in their family history. The frequent drills that occur during each cruise are just one indication of our ongoing commitment to your safety. Every member of our staff is thoroughly trained and each ship is fully equipped to handle any emergency. And we're the first cruise line in the world to have installed voyage event recorders, or "black boxes," on the bridges throughout our fleet, and the first cruise line with sprinklers and fire detection systems on all balconies. We're the only cruise line ever to have received the coveted International James E. McGuire Safety Award. As you can see, the safety and security of our passengers and crew are the first priorities of all officers on a Princess ship. Nothing comes before that.

#### PROTECTING THE OCEANS AND YOUR HEALTH

Princess knows how important environmental and health concerns are to all of our passengers. During the past five years, we have invested millions of dollars in waste management technology and education. In recognition of our efforts, Princess was honored by the U.S. Coast Guard with the William M. Benker Environmental Award. We also received the Pacific Asia Travel Association's Green Leaf Gold Award and the British Airways Tourism for Tomorrow Award for our work in protecting the environment.

We are moving forward with our unique and innovative sanitation and health programs. Through extensive public health training for members of the shipboard crew and regular sanitation inspections, we continue to ensure compliance with the strictest standards set by the U.S. Public Health Service inspectorate.

#### PRINCESS' MEDICAL STANDARDS

**Medical Staff.** Maritime medicine is a very specialized practice. The United Kingdom is a country well-known for its maritime medicine tradition, and all shipboard medical staff, both doctors and nurses, are full-time shipboard

practitioners licensed in the United Kingdom. Medical staff are not retained on a short-term or a "services in exchange for passage" basis. In addition to a medical degree, all shipboard doctors have at least three years of postgraduate medical training, including experience in primary care, minor surgery, emergency medical care and cardiac care, and they are all certified in Advanced Life Support. At least one doctor on every ship is also certified in Advanced Trauma Life Support. Additionally, all doctors and nurses are obliged to participate in continuing medical education each year.

The shipboard medical staff is fluent in English, on call 24 hours a day and easily reached through the ship's 911 emergency number. The number of medical staff ranges from two doctors and five nurses to one doctor and two nurses, depending on the size of the ship.

**Medical Centers.** When illness strikes or an emergency arises, your shipboard medical staff has the resources of our well-equipped shipboard medical centers at their disposal. Our medical centers are stocked with X-ray machines, computerized EKG machines, portable oxygen cylinders, cardiac monitors, oxygen saturation monitors, volumetric infusion pumps, cardiac defibrillators and external pacemakers, and our pharmacies are equipped with medications approved by the U.K. Committee on Safety of Medicines.

#### PRINCESS ACCESS<sup>SM</sup>

A cruise escape with Princess is for everyone. We've put a great deal of thought into making our ships comfortable for all our guests, and we are proud to offer a variety of accessible staterooms and have made most public areas accessible as well. Many of our elevators have Braille call buttons and audible arrival announcements. And we welcome service animals. For details, contact Princess at 1-800-PRINCESS (800-774-6237).

Passengers can also request an "All-in-One Kit" that includes telephone amplifier, visual smoke detector, door knocker sensor, text telephone, and other aids for guests with hearing loss. We are happy to work closely with our passengers to provide an accessible cruise experience. Please see the ship deck plans of this brochure for the locations of wheelchair-accessible staterooms. Accessibility on land tours will vary by destination, so please call us at 1-800-PRINCESS for more detailed information.



# GENERAL INFORMATION

"Princess" or "Princess Cruises" as used herein refers to and means the "Carrier" as defined in the Passage Contract. Transportation of passengers and baggage on Princess ships is provided by the Carrier and is governed by the terms and conditions of the Passage Contract which forms part of your cruise ticket and represents the entire agreement between the Carrier and the passenger. It is important that you carefully read the entire Passage Contract, a copy of which is available on our website, [princess.com](http://princess.com), or which may be obtained from your travel agent or Princess Cruise Lines, Ltd., and which sets forth the rights and responsibilities of Princess and the passenger. Princess vessels are registered in Bermuda and are operated as specified in the Passage Contract.

**Fares.** Brochure Fares and other amounts shown are quoted in U.S. dollars unless stated otherwise; are available in North America only; are per adult based on double occupancy (except single-occupant staterooms); are computed on the basis of number of nights accommodated onboard ship and/or land as set forth in your travel itinerary ("the itinerary"); and represent the maximum fares for the given category. "Cruise fares" and "cruisetour fares" include accommodations from the initial point of vessel embarkation to the final point of disembarkation as specified in the itinerary, and all regular meals and entertainment while onboard. "Cruise fares" and "cruisetour fares" do not include airfare (unless specifically mentioned), transfers (except as noted in the itinerary), shore excursions, sightseeing or meals ashore (except as noted in the itinerary); government fees and taxes; gratuities to ship and airport personnel, waiters, escorts and drivers (except as noted in the itinerary); beverages (not part of the regular menu); laundry service, or any other item of a personal nature. Virtually all passengers will qualify for one or more reductions from Brochure Fares, and the amount of the reductions may vary. The cruise ticket and hotel packages are valid only for the named passenger and may not be sold or transferred.

**Government Fees and Taxes.** "Government Fees and Taxes" may include any and all fees, charges, tolls and taxes imposed by U.S. and/or foreign governmental or quasi-governmental authorities, including but not limited to U.S. customs fees, head taxes, Panama Canal tolls, dockage fees, wharfage fees, air taxes, hotel or VAT taxes incurred as part of a land tour, inspection fees, immigration and naturalization fees, and Internal Revenue service fees, whether assessed on a per passenger, per berth, per ton or per vessel basis. In the case of per ton or per vessel assessments, those assessments will be spread over the passenger capacity of the ship. Government Fees and Taxes are subject to change and Princess reserves the right to collect any increases in effect at the time of sailing, even if the fare has already been paid in full.

**Fares, Other Changes and Schedules Subject to Change.** Every effort will be made to adhere to the specifics shown herein and in the itinerary; however, circumstances may necessitate alterations. All fares for cruises and cruisetours and/or air/sea packages or other charges as well as schedules, port calls, hours of arrival and departure and special programs are subject to change without prior notice. Princess shall not be required to refund any portion of fares or other charges nor make any other compensation under these circumstances. Accordingly, Princess is not responsible for the change or cancellation of any personally scheduled event because of alterations to the itinerary of any cruise or land tour. Any cruise may be cancelled by Princess. Rates are published herein and no verbal quote to the contrary will be honored.

Princess reserves the right to collect any fare increase in effect at the time of sailing, even if the fare has already been paid in full.

**Reservations.** A deposit must be received within 24 hours to three days of booking depending on the departure date. The per person deposit required is \$250-\$900, depending on the cruise length. For combined cruises, a deposit is required for each segment. Deposits are not required for 3rd or 4th berth passengers. Formal confirmation will be made to the passenger's travel agent when the deposit is received. For non-holiday sailings and sailings of less than 20 days, all final payments are due no less than 75 days prior to departure. Final payments for Christmas and New Year's sailings and 20+ day sailings are due no less than 90 days prior to departure. Bookings made within 75-15 days prior to departure require full payment within 24 hours. Bookings made within 14 days of departure require full payment at time of booking. Staterooms are subject to cancellation if deposit/payments are not received within the periods stated above. All agent check payments for cruises and cruisetours should be sent to: Princess, Attn: Revenue Accounting, 24844 Ave. Rockefeller, Santa Clarita, California 91355. All agent credit card payments for cruises should be phoned in to 1-800-421-1700. All agent credit card payments for cruisetours should be phoned in to 1-800-426-0442. We are unable to accept MCOs (Miscellaneous Charge Orders) for payment.

**Documentation.** Princess mails a Pre-Cruise Information Packet approximately 75 days prior to departure. This packet includes a letter, a copy of the Cruise Answer Book, Adventures Ashore brochure, bag tags and other information you will find useful before departure. This packet is sent after full payment is received by Princess. Follow the Pre-Cruise Checklist in the Cruise Answer Book, access the Cruise Personalizer at [princess.com](http://princess.com), enter the mandatory immigration information, and you will be able to print your Boarding Pass. Cruise tickets are no longer issued by Princess. Airline eTicket receipts or paper air tickets, may be sent via fax, mail or email to your travel agent approximately 14 days prior to departure. If Internet access is not available, your travel agent will assist you in securing the necessary information or call 1-800-PRINCESS for assistance.

**Cancellation of Reservations.** Cancellation notices must be received by Princess via telephone, or via electronic device through a Princess authorized Computerized Reservation System (CRS). Changes of sailing date or substitution of passenger names are considered to be cancellations and new bookings. All sailing date changes and name substitutions are subject to space availability and, if accepted, are subject to the rates, discounts, cancellation fees and booking conditions in effect at the time of the change or substitution.

**Cancellation Fees and Refunds.** The following policy applies to all cancellations with respect to Cruise or Cruisetour Fare, air add-ons, and pre-cruise and post-cruise package charges ("Total Charges"):

Any refund owed to you will be made directly to your credit card account or your travel agent and you must receive your refund directly from these sources. If you have purchased air through our FlightChoice air travel program, all refunds of total charges will be held until the air tickets have been returned to Princess. Some travel agents may, at their discretion, withhold an agency cancellation fee. Princess is not responsible for payments made to the passenger's travel agent but not received by Princess, or for the passenger's receipt of any refund which Princess has paid to the passenger's travel agent. There will be no refund of cancellation or interruption fees by Princess under any circumstances. You must recover such fees from your own insurance or from Princess Travel Care<sup>SM</sup>/Princess Travel Care Gold<sup>SM</sup>.

**Princess Travel Care Cruise Protection.** With Princess Travel Care, you'll be covered up to the full value of your trip. Please contact your travel agent for a description of this program and refer to the Princess Travel Care information pamphlet for specific details. Rates for Princess Travel Care and Princess Travel Care Gold are subject to change without notice. Please contact your travel agent for current rates.

**Change Fees.** A \$50 service fee per passenger, per change will be assessed for each change to the cruise, cruisetour or Cruise Plus Hotel Packages beginning 45 days prior to sailing. However, no change will be made unless permitted under our cancellation policy. The service fee will not be assessed when upgrading stateroom accommodations. Air tickets may not be changed within 30 days of your departure. Additional charges may be assessed for changes to air tickets or air reservations.

**Baggage Handling.** Princess makes every effort to assist its passengers in safeguarding their belongings and valuables, but all passengers' belongings are at owner's risk at all times. Hand or unlocked baggage, breakables, medicines, travel documents and valuables must be hand-carried by the passenger at all times. Princess is not responsible for money, jewelry, cameras, binoculars, documents or any other articles which you retain in your personal control or stateroom. To protect your valuables, you may use the safety deposit box in your stateroom. For flights within land tours to and from the ship, weight restrictions on baggage apply.

**Stateroom Occupancy.** Occupancy of any stateroom(s) is limited to the number of berths in that stateroom. Princess reserves the right to limit the number of upper berths and single staterooms sold.

**Important Notice Concerning Safety.** Princess visits a large number of ports in numerous countries around the world. At any given moment there are likely to be "trouble spots" in the world in terms of crime and/or war or terrorist actions. While Princess endeavors to provide reasonable protection for your comfort and safety onboard its ships, Princess cannot guarantee freedom from all risks associated with war, terrorism, crime or other potential sources of harm. The U.S. Department of State and other similar government agencies regularly issue advisories and warnings to travelers giving details of local conditions in specified cities and countries according to such agency's perception of risks to travelers. We strongly recommend that passengers and their travel agents obtain and consider such information when making travel decisions. Princess reserves the right to make any changes to any itinerary at any time.

**Travel Agents.** Your travel agent acts for you in making the arrangements, including your deposits and payments, for your trip/cruise. Travel agencies are not owned or operated by Princess. We invite you to visit your favorite travel agent to make your Princess reservations or call 1-800-PRINCESS.

**Travel and Health Documents.** Passport and visa requirements and regulations with regard to vaccination certificates and other health requirements for the various embarkation ports may vary by destination and change from time to time. It is the sole responsibility of the passenger to obtain and have available when necessary the appropriate valid travel and health documents such as passports, visas, vaccination certificates, etc., that are necessary for air travel, disembarkation at the various ports of call and re-entry into the appropriate country of origin. Passengers who do not possess the proper documentation will be prevented from boarding the flight or vessel without refund of the cruise or cruisetour fare and will be subject to any fine or other costs incurred by Princess which result from the lack of proper documentation. Passengers should consult their travel agent for full details regarding required documentation. If traveling with minors, please see requirements under Children section.

**Health, Disability and Wheelchair Notice.** Passengers must notify Princess in writing (Attention: Customer Service) at the time of booking of any physical or mental illness, disability or other condition for which special accommodation or the use of a wheelchair, power wheelchair or scooter is contemplated or necessary, or which may require medical treatment or render the passenger unfit to travel or which may constitute a risk or danger to the passenger or anyone else onboard the ship. We recommend passengers using a wheelchair travel with someone who is able to assist them both ashore and at sea. Some ports of call require tenders to go ashore and may preclude passengers using a wheelchair from leaving the vessel; this decision must be made by the ship's Captain and is binding. Passengers must bring wheelchairs for their own use on land portion of cruisetours and Cruise Plus. A limited number of manual wheelchairs can be reserved for use during your cruise. If you have purchased Princess FlightChoice Air and have any special in-flight requirements like a wheelchair or oxygen, this request must be made directly by you with the air carrier. Not all airlines allow the use of oxygen in-flight.

**Refusal of Passage and Premature Disembarkation.** Passage may be refused to any passenger, and any passenger's vacation may be terminated at any time, at the risk and expense of the person disembarked, where the passenger's behavior, or physical or mental condition renders him or her, in the opinion of the ship's physician, unfit for travel or a risk or danger to himself or herself or to anyone else onboard the ship.

Additionally, the ship's Captain may refuse transportation to any passenger or may terminate any passenger's voyage who, in the sole discretion of the ship's Captain, is believed to be dangerous to himself or others or whose presence onboard causes or may cause disturbances to Princess' passengers or crew, including those passengers engaging in excessive, disruptive, or obscene behavior. Such passenger may be left at any port or place the ship calls without any liability to Princess. Princess shall not be required to refund any portion of the fare paid by any passenger who must leave the vacation prematurely for any of the reasons set forth above or who voluntarily disembarks or leaves the ship for any other reason, nor shall it be responsible for lodging, medical, meals, return transportation or other expenses incurred by the passenger. Princess reserves the right to refuse to do business with any person.

**Medical Facilities and Staff.** Princess is not a healthcare provider and is not liable for any act or omission of doctors, nurses or other providers of service or those under their orders with respect to the treatment, advice, care or services of any kind given by such persons to any passenger. These medical providers exercise their own medical judgment and expertise.



**Pregnancy.** Princess cannot accept passengers who will have entered the 24th week of pregnancy by the end of the vacation.

**Children/Age Requirements.** Children under six months are not permitted to travel to Alaska, Australia, New Zealand, Canada & New England, Caribbean & Mexican Riviera, Europe and Panama Canal. Children under twelve months are not permitted to travel to Africa, Asia, Antarctica, Indian Subcontinent, South Pacific, Tahiti, Hawaii, South America and on Transatlantic and Transpacific sailings. Princess reserves the right to restrict the number of those between the ages of six months and 17 years aboard the vessel. Effective for all bookings made on or after August 1, 2007, all passengers under the age of 21 years must be accompanied by a passenger who is 21 years or older. For family groups booking multiple staterooms, children may still sail in a cabin without their parents or guardians, provided one child in the stateroom is a minimum of 16 years of age or older. Please note that notarized written consent for passengers under the age of 18 is no longer required by Princess. However, several countries require special documentation for children traveling without both parents; these requirements are subject to change without notice. It is your responsibility to ensure that you possess the proper documents for all of the countries that you will visit. Please verify requirements with the immigration offices prior to your cruise. Minimum age for cruisetours is 6-12 months, depending upon destination and tour (5 years for escorted tours in Alaska). Passengers under the age of 18 are not permitted in the disco/nightclub after 11 p.m. Be sure to check with the Youth and Teen Centers for special disco events designed for kids and teens.

**Pets.** We are unable to accommodate any animals onboard the vessel, except for certain service animals of passengers with disabilities.

**Shore Excursions and Land Tours.** These tours are operated by local independent companies. In selling tickets for these optional programs, Princess acts only for other independent companies who provide such programs as independent contractors and from whom Princess gets a commission. Princess shall not be liable for any loss, damage, injury, illness or death arising from or occurring during a shore excursion or tour whether or not such shore excursion or tour was purchased through Princess.

**Land and Air Arrangements.** Princess shall not be liable for any loss, damage, injury, illness, death, cost or delay arising from or in connection with the services and facilities provided by or any act of an independent contractor such as airline, hotel, tour, restaurant, rail or any other transport operator, etc., whether or not such arrangements were made by Princess.

**Cruise Plus® Programs.** Prices have been based on exchange rates at time of printing and are subject to change without notice. Princess reserves the right to substitute hotels of similar type and other features of the tour or hotel package. Bookings made for Cruise Plus hotel packages and tours after tickets have been issued may result in a higher cost due to changes in air reservations. All waitlists for Cruise Plus packages will be closed 60 days prior to departure and no new waitlists will be accepted. Due to flight arrival times, rooms may not be available upon arrival. Hotel check-in times vary, but are generally between 3 p.m. and 5 p.m. unless otherwise stated. Check-out times vary between 10 a.m. and noon. All room assignments are determined by and are the responsibility of the hotel. Hotel loyalty programs are at the discretion of the individual hotel properties. Cruise Plus passengers will forfeit all complimentary hotel overnights which coincide with the Cruise Plus package.

**Claims for Injury, Illness or Death/Notice Requirements/Time Limits.** Any incident or accident resulting in injury, illness or death to the passenger, whether occurring onboard ship, in connection with pre- or post-cruise accommodations, or during a shore excursion (independent or purchased through Princess), must be reported immediately to a ship's officer or Princess. Carrier shall not be liable for and no suit shall be maintainable for emotional or

bodily injury, illness or death to the passenger unless (A) a written claim with full particulars is presented to carrier within six (6) months of the incident or accident and (B) a lawsuit on such claim is commenced within one (1) year from the date of the emotional or bodily injury, illness or death, whichever comes first, and valid service of the lawsuit is made within ninety (90) days of the suit. In all other cases, no lawsuit may be brought against carrier unless (A) written notice giving full particulars of the claim is delivered to carrier within fifteen (15) days of the actual or scheduled termination of the cruise, whichever comes first, and (B) a lawsuit on such claim is filed within six (6) months from the date of the actual or scheduled termination of the cruise or the cruise cancellation, whichever comes first, and valid service of the lawsuit is made within ninety (90) days of the suit. In certain situations, arbitration will be required. If you choose to sue Princess Cruise Lines, Ltd., all disputes and matters whatsoever against Princess arising out of or relating in any way to your cruise or the booking/cancellation of your cruise shall be litigated by you, if at all, in Los Angeles, California.

**Smoking, Drinking and Gaming.** Smoking is allowed in passenger staterooms, balconies and most public rooms, but the show lounges and dining rooms and all food service areas onboard all Princess ships are non-smoking. Passengers must be 21 years of age or older to purchase or drink alcohol or gamble onboard all Princess ships at all times. Passengers under 21 years of age are not permitted to purchase or consume alcohol or gamble onboard a Princess vessel. Duty-free alcohol is available for purchase in our gift shops onboard and will be delivered to your stateroom on the last day of your cruise. Alcohol purchased at any port of call may not be consumed onboard. It will be collected at the gangway for safe-keeping and delivered to your stateroom on the last day of your cruise, prior to disembarkation. You may bring one bottle of wine and/or champagne onboard to celebrate a special occasion. Wine and/or champagne brought onboard and consumed in the dining rooms or alternative restaurants will be subject to a \$15 USD per bottle corkage fee.

**FlightChoice Program and Passenger Transfer Gateway Cities.** The availability of the air travel program may be limited from each gateway. Princess reserves the right to withdraw any gateway city without prior notice. Within 21 days of departure, the air travel program is on a request basis and may be unavailable.

**Ticketing.** If you have purchased Princess FlightChoice or FlightChoice Plus air, you will receive an air receipt, by fax or email with your electronic air ticket details. This fax or email is sent beginning 45 days prior to departure. Depending on your itinerary, paper air tickets may be required and will be sent under a separate mailing. These tickets must be presented to the airline for travel. Princess reserves the right to choose the air carrier, routing and airport for each gateway city. Princess may use a charter air service. Airfares used are capacity-controlled, promotional, may be nonrefundable and are subject to change. Princess may issue paper or electronic airline tickets. Airline tickets issued by Princess are highly restrictive and subject to cancellation and change fees. Because of this, you may find that your air ticket cannot be reissued, revalidated, or exchanged for another carrier or routing. All airline tickets are the property of Princess and must be returned to and are refundable only to Princess. Flight schedules may require the use of overnight flights or connections en route to your final destination or cruise departure. A fee may apply if you change or cancel your air arrangements prior to air tickets being used. Any additional costs, including fees for cancellations/rebookings will be made at the passenger's expense. An additional \$75 per person for domestic and \$125 for international flights reissue fee will be charged for changes made beginning 75 days prior to sailing. Passengers booked in the same cabin but who originate from different gateway cities may not receive routing on the same flights. Passengers traveling together, but booked or deposited at different times, may be required to travel on different flights. Passengers traveling in groups may be required to travel on different flights.

**Air Departure Taxes.** Some countries require passengers to pay an airport departure tax which is not included on the passenger air ticket. The individual passengers are responsible for this tax. In most cases, this tax is collected at the airport upon check-in and may have to be paid in local currency. We recommend your travel agent verify any applicable tax for which the passenger may be responsible.

**Air Charges.** Air charges include all air fees and taxes that are included in the air add-on price and specifically include U.S. Excise Tax and certain Passenger Fuel Surcharges. Air charges vary by gateway city and routing and are averaged for each gateway city.

**Air Fees, Taxes and Surcharges.** Air fees, taxes and surcharges may include any and all fees, charges and taxes related to air transportation imposed by U.S. and/or foreign governmental or quasi-governmental authorities, including airport facility charges, departure taxes, security taxes and surcharges, airport service charges and government inspection fees. Air fees, taxes and surcharges vary by gateway city, routing, destination and carrier. Air fees, taxes and surcharges are estimated for each FlightChoice gateway city. Actual air fees and taxes may be higher or lower. Refunds will not be made if actual air fees and taxes are lower than estimated. Princess reserves the right to collect any increases in air fees and taxes in effect at the time of sailing, even if the fare has already been paid in full.

**Air Customizations.** Subject to availability, Princess will fly passengers directly to or from their cruise destination as requested by the passenger. A nonrefundable cost of \$50 per person will apply per customization request in addition to any fare differential. Requests for bookings under deposit must be made between 320 and 14 days prior to departure. Where applicable, passengers confirmed to travel on days other than those normally scheduled by Princess will forfeit all complimentary hotel overnights and transfers between the airport and pier as provided by Princess. All customizations are subject to availability and confirmation. In the event of airline schedule change, it may be necessary to rebook custom air flights. Additional charges may apply. Passengers who have a special travel need or requirement for early air ticketing may request this service by calling Princess Cruises reservations and asking for FlightChoice Plus. Provided the required flights are confirmed and the booking is paid in full, Princess can issue early air tickets. The fee for each request is \$50 for voyages within North America and \$75 for international voyages. Additional changes to the air reservations after ticketing may result in additional air fees or charges. Once ticketed, a confirmation will be faxed or emailed.

**Airline In-Flight Service Requests.** Airline seat assignments cannot be confirmed by Princess. We recommend that you have your travel agent contact the airlines directly for seat assignments, the addition of frequent flyer numbers to your airline record, or to request special meals. Please be advised that not all airlines provide pre-reserved seats, add frequent flyer numbers to records or apply frequent flyer bonus upgrades to flights booked by Princess. Some airlines now charge for advance seat assignments. Additionally, some airlines may not have passenger names until 45 days prior to departure. If you have specific air travel requirements, please take advantage of our FlightChoice Plus program. See the Princess FlightChoice section for details. Requests for wheelchair assistance or other special needs, such as oxygen in-flight can only be made by you directly with the air carrier and are the responsibility of the traveler. Not all airlines allow the use of oxygen in-flight.

**Overnights.** For some cruise itineraries it may be necessary, due to flight schedules and/or availability of seats, for passengers to overnight either before or after their cruise. If it is necessary to overnight, hotel accommodations, baggage handling and transfers are at passengers' expense. Passengers will also be responsible for all meals and other items of a personal nature. Passengers may purchase a hotel accommodation/transfer package directly from Princess or they may choose to make their own arrangements. In select markets, Princess may assign

complimentary overnight stays. Hotel selection will usually be at an airport location and may not be at the port of embarkation/disembarkation. You will be advised as soon as possible if an overnight is required.

**Flight Reconfirmation.** Most airlines do not require reconfirmation of flights; however, it is strongly recommended that you verify both flight departure times and flight numbers at least 72 hours prior to your departure from home. Princess is not responsible for airline schedule or flight number changes after tickets have been issued.

**Refunds.** All airline tickets issued in conjunction with Princess' air travel program are refundable only to Princess. Any unused flight coupons must be returned to Princess (Attention: Airline Reporting Department). Princess will determine the amount of any refund due. If an air ticket is lost, the passenger is responsible for the cost of replacement.

**Princess' Transfer Program.** Cruise and cruisetour passengers may purchase transfers from the port city airport to the ship and from the ship to the port city airport. These transfers are priced separately and are available on the turnaround day only. They are available to both FlightChoice passengers and to those passengers who have made independent flight arrangements. FlightChoice passengers will automatically have transfers included in their bookings. Passengers who have made independent flight arrangements must provide Princess with this information at least 45 days in advance of the departure day. As of August 12, 2007, passengers who have made independent flight arrangements must provide Princess with their flight information prior to purchasing transfers. Unused transfers are not refundable. Transfers within the land portion of cruisetours and for Cruise Plus passengers are included. Transfers at both ends of a cruisetour will be charged separately. Note: It is your responsibility to know the local regulations regarding child safety seats or other child restraint systems as well as to provide the appropriate safety device. Failure to do so may result in denied boarding on to the transfer vehicle.

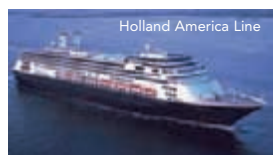

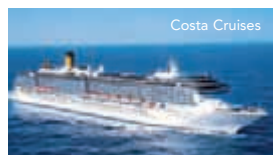

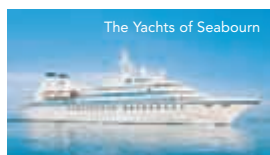
