RE: SVAM/SSG SECURITY COMPLIANCE

Dear Valued Supplier,

To ensure compliance with security matters and facilitate dockside delivery, Princess Cruises requires all suppliers delivering direct to vessel to access our security site SVAM and complete the online requested information.

Buyers and Princess Employees authorizing or instructing you to deliver dockside shall send notification to SSG, who will email you a link to SVAM to complete delivery details.

All drivers and company representatives accessing dockside facilities must possess required proper government credentials: United States-TWIC, Canada-TSC and/or Fast Card. Drivers not in compliance with credentials shall be escorted by PCL or Port designees and a fee of \$25 shall be levied against Supplier's delivery.

Be advised that failure to complete and properly comply with these instructions may prohibit your transport entry into secure areas to make the required delivery and subject you to penalties. Failure to complete SVAM details which result in non-delivery shall require your Company to deliver required goods at next port-of-call and at your expense. Dock security allows for the controlled and expedited flow of materials onto our vessels and your compliance is required to ensure successful operations.
