Princess Local Partnerships



Princess and our guests are giving back to the communities that already give so much to us. That’s why we created the Princess Local Partnerships Program. Through a period of consultation with local communities, local governments and stakeholders, our crew and our guests, we understood what was most important to Aotearoa / New Zealand. Conservation of the ecological environment and Māori culture. Starting in the beautiful Bay of Islands in New Zealand, right down to Dunedin in the Port of Otago, we have worked with local community groups to assist with conservation programs that deliver on these efforts.

Blue Penguin colony, Otago

In association with Natures Wonders, Princess has built more nesting boxes for the flourishing Blue Penguin colony and extended the predator-free boundary, which will have a huge impact on Blue Penguin numbers. Additionally conservation efforts are being replicated to preserve the Yellow-Eyed Penguin colony nearby which is the last major colony on the mainland of New Zealand. Guests will be able to see the results when they visit Dunedin.

Increasing Kiwi numbers, Ōpua State Forest, Bay of Islands

The hard work of the Bay Bush Action trustees and volunteers, together with the generous donations from Princess guests, has seen a 120% increase in Kiwi numbers in the Ōpua State Forest and revival of the Kukupa and the flightless Weka native bird species in the region. The support has allowed the Bush Bay Action group to work on restoring a forest that has been forgotten about for over 25 years; as well as creating jobs and supporting the local economy. It has been so heartening to see the increase in Kiwi numbers and the regeneration of native plants in Ōpua State Forest, which we couldn’t have done without the generous donations of Princess guests.

Training Future Celestial Navigators

In 2025 we welcomed Te Kura Waka – a Tauranga-based celestial navigation school as a new partner in the programme. Dedicated to preserving the ancient art of Pacific wayfinding, Te Kura Waka trains the next generation of navigators to read the sun, moon, stars and planets, keeping alive the proud seafaring traditions at the heart of Māori culture.

Princess donated \$100,000 in 2019 to initiate the program. On all cruises to New Zealand as part of an ongoing voluntary guest donation program, we continue to expand the program and deliver real change.

Tips for your trip

First things first

When should I book?

You should book your cruise holiday as soon as you can. This will ensure that you have the greatest choice available, as holiday periods can be very popular and sell out early. Keep this in mind, book early.

Things to know before you go

Where can I find out more about my cruise holiday?

Once you have made your booking, you can access the 'Princess® App' to view your cruise details, including your stateroom, itinerary, pre/post cruise arrangements and dining options. You can also pre-book shore excursions, spa treatments, special occasion packages and more from 120 days prior to sailing.

Do I need travel insurance?

Australian Medicare, New Zealand ACC and private health insurance will not cover you for any medical costs onboard. We strongly recommend all guests purchase comprehensive travel insurance, even for domestic cruises, to ensure they are covered if things do not go according to plan. Costs are incurred for onboard or onshore medical fees, medical evacuation charges, cancellation and travel change fees, and any other associated costs, unless they are covered under travel insurance.

Some ports included in your itinerary may also have a requirement for you to have a valid international travel insurance policy to be able to visit. You should confirm the requirements at the time of booking. Currently all ports in New Caledonia require guests to have comprehensive international travel insurance.

Guests should ensure they read the product disclosure statement for any insurance policy they are considering ensuring it provides the level of cover they need, including cruise travel, and any pre-existing conditions.

Where can I find more information about passports, visas and vaccinations?

What is the latest time I can check-in for my cruise?

Most cruises have a staggered check in process. Please refer to the Princess® App for your scheduled check in time. Check-in closes one (1) hour prior to your cruise's scheduled departure time as displayed on your ticket. Checking-in after this time will cause you to miss your cruise and no refunds will be given.

Can I book my flights with you?

Yes, flights can be booked with our Princess EZair® program from approximately 330 days prior to the last day of sailing and up to 4 days prior to the cruise departure, subject to availability. The cruise booking must be completed, and a cruise deposit must be paid before any air travel can be booked, although flights may be searched for when checking your cruise booking availability. Take a look at the Princess EZair® page in this brochure for more details.

I have flights booked through Princess Cruises®, can I check-in online?

Yes, your flight reference number will be printed on your Princess Cruises eTicket.

If I am booking my own flights, what arrival and departure times do you recommend?

For Royal Princess®, Majestic Princess®, Diamond Princess®, Crown Princess® and Grand Princess® departures from Australia or New Zealand - please ensure your flight times meet the following guidelines:

For all other Princess Cruises® departures, including sectors of the World Cruise, please contact your Travel Agent or our Cruise Contact Centre for the most suitable arrangements for your itinerary.

When you are making your own flight bookings, missed connections are always a possibility, so the more time you allow for unforeseen delays at either end of your cruise, the better.

If you do need to make changes to your own flight bookings, your chosen airline may charge fees; so check their airfare conditions when you book.

I take medication; do I need to let you know?

Yes, if you have a medical condition or take medication it must be advised at time of booking. We will send you a health questionnaire to complete so we have all necessary information. We want you to be safe and comfortable on your cruise, so bring enough medication to last you until the end of your holiday. It is also a good idea to bring a few extra days supply in case of any unforeseen delays.

Can I bring my medical equipment to use onboard?

In most cases, yes. To ensure your medical equipment will work onboard, please advise your Travel Agent or our Cruise Contact Centre at the time of booking. We will then send you an information sheet to complete. For safety reasons, your equipment will need to be checked prior to boarding.

When am I going to get my cruise documentation?

Princess Cruises® operates a paperless documentation program that promotes environmental sustainability and ensures guests receive up-to-date information in a timely manner. This program begins once you have paid your deposit and consists of a series of information emails including a downloadable travel summary. Once you have completed all your personal details via the Princess® App, and paid for your booking in full, you can download your Digital boarding pass. A Travel Summary and your luggage labels can be accessed via 'Manage Booking' on princess.com

How do I find out what shore excursions are available, and how can I book them?

General shore excursion information is available in the Shore Excursions section of our website. You can view prices and pre-book excursions for your cruise from 120 days until seven days before sailing via 'Manage Booking' on princess.com. As numbers are limited, we recommend you book early. You can also book at the Shore Excursions desk once on board.

I have limited mobility; can I go ashore in all ports?

It is important to note that access to water shuttle ports may be restricted, which may also limit your excursion options. Do not worry if you cannot go ashore, a range of activities are available onboard!

Some of our larger Princess ships may dock at freight terminals which may be located further from townships than passenger berths. In these instances ports may not have sufficient wheelchair accessible transport to accommodate all guests which may limit access for these guests.

Can I organise gifts or celebrations before sailing?

We can help you celebrate your honeymoon, birthday or anniversary onboard with one of our special occasion packages. You can also arrange a gift such as a bottle of wine and/or a box of chocolates for a friend, loved one or even yourself, up until five (5) days prior to departure. For information on these packages, search 'Special Occasions' on our website.

Packages vary by ship and exceptions apply.

Can I get married or renew my vows onboard?

Yes, let Princess Cruises® help you create memories to last a lifetime. We offer a wide variety of special packages for weddings and vow renewals on most of our ships. Visit our website for more information or to download a brochure.

How much luggage can I bring?

We recommend no more than two (2) bags per person. Each bag can be no bigger than 140cm x 60cm x 40cm and cannot weigh more than 32kg. It is important to remember that airlines may have different luggage restrictions.

Can my friends and family see me off?

Family and friends are welcome to share in your excitement and wave farewell from the cruise terminal. Due to security reasons, they will be unable to come onboard with you.

Welcome aboard!

What’s included in my cruise fare?

Your cruise fare includes onboard accommodation, ocean transportation, select main meals onboard, some non-alcoholic beverages and most entertainment. Excluded are meals at some alternate dining venues, meals on hosted land tours unless noted otherwise, transfers and items of a personal nature such as, but not limited to, spa services, shore excursions, beverages and some snacks, photographs, gratuities and medical services. Other services may be available at the time you sail, as we are constantly striving to enhance our product.

What do I wear onboard?

During the day, casual clothes are suitable. After 5.30pm, smart casual attire is required in the public lounges and restaurants or as published in the ship’s newsletter. On formal evenings, we suggest gentlemen wear a suit, or jacket and tie, and for ladies an evening or cocktail dress.

How many formal/theme nights will there be?

Cruises up to 14 nights duration usually feature two or three formal nights, cruises up to 28 nights duration usually feature three (3) or four (4) formal nights, while longer cruises feature a minimum of five (5) formal nights. Please refer to ‘Manage Booking’ on princess.com for specific information on your cruise.

In addition, ships departing from and returning to Australia usually feature theme nights on cruises seven (7) nights or more. These theme nights may vary from cruise to cruise. Themed accessories may be purchased onboard. You will be notified of the themes once onboard through the ship’s newsletter.

What is the currency onboard?

All prices onboard ships departing and returning to Australia are in Australian Dollars. Crown Princess® World cruise and sectors, repositioning voyages from Asia to Australia and vice versa, are in Australian dollars. Prices onboard all other Princess Cruises® ships including Transpacifics from/to Los Angeles, San Francisco and Vancouver (including sectors on reposition sailings from Auckland to Sydney and vice versa), Diamond Princess® and Sapphire Princess® cruises departing and returning to Japan/Singapore are in US Dollars.

How do I pay onboard?

At embarkation, you will receive your personal Medallion, which will also be your security pass and door key. Yet another convenience of sailing with Princess Cruises® is being able to simply tap your Medallion for all purchases. An itemised onboard account will be delivered to your stateroom at the end of your cruise. We recommend that you pre-register your credit or debit card details online at ‘Manage Booking’ on princess.com or at embarkation for an express check-out. We accept Visa, MasterCard and AMEX. **A 1.1% service fee will be charged for guests settling their onboard account via credit card.** Debit cards act as a credit card, whilst using the available funds in your bank account. When using credit or debit cards, we obtain pre-authorisations and some banks hold these for up to 30 days. This may appear as a double charge to your credit or debit card until your bank releases the hold.

If you do not have a credit or debit card, you can activate your onboard account with cash or traveller’s cheques, by paying a minimum deposit of AUD300 (or USD300 according to ship currency) per person. On ships with USD onboard currency, USD, CAD, GBP and EUR currencies are also accepted (please refer to question ‘What is the currency onboard?’)

For all round world cruises, shipboard accounts being settled by credit or debit card, will be settled in full and charged to the nominated card at the end of each published sector. We recommend you make arrangements with your card provider prior to the cruise to settle your personal card accounts whilst you are away.

Do you have ATMs onboard?

Yes, ATM facilities are available onboard all our ships.

Can I do my laundry onboard?

Our ships provide laundromats for self service washing and ironing. Laundry services are also available. Charges apply for these services.

Are there safety deposit boxes?

Yes, there are safety deposit boxes located in every stateroom.

Are there queen beds available?

Most staterooms can have queen beds, as long as the upper beds are not in use. Please note that bed frame size descriptions are provided as a guide only and may not conform with standard Australian dimensions. Please check at time of booking.

What type of electrical sockets are onboard?

Each stateroom has other amenities for your convenience, such as a private safe and refrigerator. In addition, each room is equipped with a 110-volt, 60-cycle alternating current (AC) with standard US (3 prong) plug fittings (one 220-volt Australian socket is also available for Royal and Majestic Princess®). If you have any questions, ask your steward to check your appliances for suitability before use. All ships are equipped with an electric hair dryer in every stateroom.

Should I bring my hairdryer?

Why take up extra space in your luggage, when we have a hairdryer in every stateroom.

Is there duty-free shopping onboard?

Yes, we offer incredible tax and duty free savings off suggested retail prices on fragrances, cosmetics, jewellery, gifts, apparel, accessories and liquor. In accordance with regulation from the Australian Customs and Border Protections

Service, our onboard boutiques will remain closed during coastal cruises. Guests joining an international cruise ships only to travel between Australian ports are not entitled to duty-free benefits or concessions. Please visit <http://www.border.gov.au/Trav/Ente/Duty-Free-concessions> for more information.

Is there a doctor onboard?

Yes, please refer to the ‘Your Health’ section in our Passage Contract, commencing on page 84.

What should I do if I suffer from motion sickness?

You can consult a healthcare professional prior to boarding, and prepare by purchasing medication or special magnetic wrist bands before you leave home. Motion sickness can also be treated onboard; medication is usually available for purchase and treatment can be provided by the ship’s doctor.

Any charges from the onboard medical centre will be added to your ‘Cruise Card’ and you will be provided with an itemised account. You may be able to claim a reimbursement from your travel insurance company.

How do I keep in touch with home?

Stay connected with family and friends with MedallionNet®, our fast and reliable Wi-Fi at sea (charges apply). You can make calls from the phone in your stateroom. Please note phone charges are higher than on land and Wi-Fi access is subject to satellite coverage.

Can I use my mobile phone?

Mobile phone reception is available onboard all of our ships. A compatible mobile phone and a service plan capable of roaming internationally with Maritime Communications Partners (AS) is required. Make sure you check with your service provider for applicable charges before you depart.

How do I make dining reservations and arrangements for special dietary needs?

Customise your dining with reservations for main dining or specialty restaurants at your preferred time and pace on the Princess® App. Visit ‘Manage Booking’ on princess.com to make your special dietary requests. Please note that reservation times are based on venue capacity and availability.

What is a Crew Incentive?

During your cruise, you will meet many members of our staff in a variety of locations as they provide you with impeccable service.

The Crew incentive (tipping) is not required or charged to your onboard account when sailing on a Princess ship that departs and returns to Australia and/or operates with Australian currency onboard (please refer to question ‘What is the currency onboard?’). You are welcome to reward our onboard crew for exceptional service, however, tipping is not required. For all other Princess Cruises® ships, to save you the worry of who to tip and how much, a gratuity will be automatically added to your onboard account and may be adjusted or removed at your discretion onboard, as follows: US19.00 for Suites and Sanctuary Collection, US18.00 for Sanctuary Mini, Mini-Suites, Cabanas and Reserve Collection, US17.00 for all other staterooms, per guest, per day (including children).

This charge will be shared amongst those staff who help provide and support your cruise experience, including the wait staff, stateroom stewards, buffet stewards, galley staff, laundry staff and others.

What is the bar and wine charge?

For ships departing from and returning to Australia (and/or with Australian currency onboard) there is no bar and wine charge (please refer to question ‘What is the currency onboard?’).

For all other ships, an 18% service charge is automatically added to any beverages purchased. This service charge is shared amongst the beverage staff and their support team, including cleaners and utility workers.

Where can I smoke?

Smoking is only permitted in selected areas on our ships. These areas will be communicated to you onboard.

Other bits and pieces

I have booked through a travel agency; can I still contact you directly?

Your Travel Agent is the expert in arranging your holiday. While we are happy to discuss general information about your cruise, we are unable to discuss any aspect of your booking with anyone other than a representative of your travel agency. Please contact your Travel Agent for specific details, requests or to make changes to your booking.

When is GST payable?

GST is included in all Australian domestic voyage fares, flights, transfers, hotel packages and for Australian domestic shore excursions.

Why is GST charged on certain voyages that visit an international port?

GST is included in the fare paid for voyages which are predominantly domestic in nature, specifically, any portion of the voyage where the ship is in Australian waters (such as Round Australia and Northern Australia Explorer cruises).

What if I do not embark on my cruise?

We would be sorry if you cannot make it. If you do not join us on the cruise, please refer to our cancellation policy in the Passage Contract.

What else do I need to know?

The most important information is still to come. Please read our Passage Contract which can be found on the following pages or our website, then you’re all set!

INTRODUCTION

IMPORTANT CONTRACT TERMS THAT YOU SHOULD BE AWARE OF

It is important that You and all guests in Your booking carefully read all terms and conditions that form Your Contract with Us (including but not limited to these Conditions). We specifically draw Your attention to the following clauses in these Conditions:

- i. clause (2) provides that Cruise itineraries are not guaranteed and do not form part of Your Contract, and explains that onboard offerings may vary.
- ii. clause (5) provides that services booked in addition to Your Cruise, such as flights or hotels, are supplied by Other Service Providers and their conditions will apply.
- iii. clause (7) provides that We may refuse or cancel Your booking if You have a condition that may seriously affect Your health and safety or that of others.
- iv. clauses (16) to (23) set out the ‘Cancellation and Refunds’ Policy which explains Our policies and Your rights and obligations in relation to changes to and cancellations of Your booking.
- v. clause (32) sets out the action We and/or the Captain may take if Your presence or behaviour on board presents a risk to Your health, safety or those on onboard.
- vi. clause (33) deals with ports of call and explains that if You go ashore at a port of call, You do so at Your own risk.
- vii. clauses (38)b), (38)d), (38)f) and (38)g) outline limitations on Our liability to You in connection with Your Cruise including with respect to the supply of Recreational Services, lost or damaged luggage or personal belongings, and services provided by Other Service Providers;
- viii. clause (38)c) provides that You will indemnify Us for certain losses We suffer as a result of Your breach of Your Contract with Us.
- ix. clause (43) authorises Us to handle Your personal information in accordance with Our Privacy Policy. The Privacy Policy also explains the circumstances in which We may disclose Your personal information to third parties.

Conditions apply subject to Consumer Laws

Certain Laws such as the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth) (‘**CCA**’), which includes the Australian Consumer Law and any applicable state based consumer legislation and consumer legislation in New Zealand (‘**Consumer Laws**’), may apply by Law for Your protection. The Consumer Laws include guarantees that Our services are provided with due care and skill, are reasonably fit for a Cruise and are provided within a reasonable time. Where We fail to provide services to You in accordance with the Consumer Laws or these Conditions, You may have a right to seek a remedy from Us in accordance with these Conditions and any applicable Law, including the Consumer Laws. These Conditions do not alter any protection given to You by Consumer Laws that cannot be excluded or limited.

Our discretions and directions

These Conditions refer to various rights that may be exercised in Our discretion, such as giving You directions on board or refusing to carry You or Your luggage on Our ship. We will exercise that discretion reasonably. In exercising Our discretion, We may take into consideration a range of factors including but not limited to Our legal obligations (including under Australian and international maritime Laws), the need to protect the health and safety of all persons on board, Our ships, Our equipment and Our reputation.

YOUR CONTRACT WITH US

1) Introduction to Your Contract with Us

The parties to the Contract

- a) You are entering into this Contract with Carnival plc trading as Princess Cruises, ARBN 107 998 443. It is contracting on behalf of itself and on behalf of the Carrier with You. **You/ Your** means You and all guests in Your booking. **We/Our/Us** means Carnival plc trading as Princess Cruises. **Carrier** includes the owner, operator, charterer or manager of the ship on which You book a Cruise or any substitute ship. We may or may not be the Carrier for the Cruise You have booked.

Your Contract with Us

- b) Your Contract with Us comprises the following terms:
 - i. this Passage Contract (‘**these Conditions**’); and
 - ii. any additional terms and conditions that apply to Your booking that are notified to You or Your travel agent at or before the time of booking (for example: terms and conditions for promotional Fares, group bookings, corporate bookings, Princess EZair®, Ezpay®, and/or wedding/vow renewals) (‘**Additional Terms**’), (collectively ‘**Contract**’).

- c) In the event of any inconsistency between these Conditions and any Additional Terms that apply to Your booking, the Additional Terms will prevail to the extent of the inconsistency.

When the Contract becomes legally binding

- d) Except as set out in clause 1(e), Your Contract with Us becomes legally binding once We receive the first payment towards Your Cruise in cleared funds. If We do not receive the first payment from You or Your travel agent either at the time of booking or within 3 days if You have requested a 3 day hold of the booking, We will cancel Your booking and no legally binding Contract will form between You and Us.

- e) If Your booking does not require any payment for Your Cruise Fare, Your Contract with Us becomes legally binding once Your booking is created and You are issued with a booking number.

Bookings made on behalf of others

- f) By making a payment, You represent that You accept and have authority from all guests (or their parent/Guardian) on Your booking(s) to accept on their behalf, these Conditions and any Additional Terms that apply to Your booking. Parents/Guardians or carers accept these Conditions and any Additional Terms that apply to Your booking and enter into the Contract on behalf of their Children and/or the person(s) for whom they are responsible for making decisions. It is important that You and all guests in Your booking read them carefully and understand them.

- g) When You book Your Cruise through a travel agent, Your travel agent accepts these Conditions and any Additional Terms that apply to Your booking and enters into this Contract on Your behalf. We will send all communications in relation to Your Cruise to Your travel agent and Your travel agent is responsible for passing those communications onto You.

- h) By boarding the ship for Your Cruise, You acknowledge that You have read and understood, and agree to be bound by these Conditions and any Additional Terms that apply to Your booking.

THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE BOOKING

2) Cruise itineraries are not guaranteed and onboard offerings may vary

- a) Many factors may affect Our ability to provide any particular planned itinerary. These include weather or environmental conditions, mechanical difficulties, civil unrest, health and safety emergencies, providing assistance to other vessels, or other unforeseen circumstances. **As a result, We cannot guarantee itineraries.**

- b) If We are unable to operate in accordance with Our planned itinerary, We may in some circumstances offer You assistance or compensation in accordance with clauses 22) or 23). You may also have additional rights to compensation under the Consumer Laws.

- c) Onboard offerings such as services, products, venues, menus and activities are subject to availability and may vary by ship and itinerary and from the descriptions and images on Our marketing material. We may make changes to the onboard offerings including due to the availability of goods and services, health and safety considerations, for operational reasons, due to changes in Laws or because We are seeking to refresh or improve onboard offerings. Nothing in this clause, however, affects Your rights at Law including under Consumer Laws.

3) Overview of Your Obligations

Comply with Our policies, procedures and directions

- a) We have in place, and may introduce, alter and/or withdraw, policies and procedures for the health, safety, comfort, enjoyment and/or general wellbeing of people relating to the Cruise. We also have policies and procedures in place so that We comply with relevant Laws in relation to Your Cruise. You must, at all times, comply with Our policies and procedures that We bring to Your attention as well as all directions from Our staff.

Comply with requests for information and/or documents

- b) We may, in connection with a legitimate business purpose, Law or legal requirement, request that You provide specific information (including personal information and sensitive information) and/or documents; and You agree to comply with Our requests.

Respect Health, Safety and Security

- c) You must conduct Yourself with due regard to the health, safety, comfort, enjoyment and general wellbeing of all persons in relation to Your Cruise.
- d) You acknowledge and agree that health, safety and security is everyone’s responsibility. At all times unsafe, abusive, offensive, illegal, disruptive behaviour and the like is prohibited in relation to Your Cruise. This can cover things like:
- i. abusive, offensive, dangerous or harassing behaviour;
 - ii. behaviour which may endanger the safety of the ship on which You are travelling, or the safety of Our staff or other people in connection with Your Cruise;
 - iii. tampering, damaging or interfering with any part of the ship (including equipment, facilities and systems);
 - iv. climbing, standing or sitting on any safety barriers;
 - v. public nudity and acts of indecency;
 - vi. littering;
 - vii. smoking outside the designated areas;
 - viii. failing to comply with directions from Our staff;
 - ix. making excessive noise which disturbs other persons onboard; and
 - x. unlawful conduct including in the ports We visit.

If You see something, say something

- e) Any injuries, incidents, anomalies, illegal activity, hazards, unsafe behaviour, disruptive behaviour, security matters in connection with Your Cruise must be reported to Us/Our staff as soon as possible.

Prepare Yourself for the Cruise

- f) It is Your responsibility to ensure that at all times You are fully and properly informed about, and comply with, all Laws, orders and customs in relation to Your Cruise and which are in place at the destinations We plan to visit during Your Cruise. This covers things like:
- i. making all necessary enquiries as to whether You need a visa and/or other documents to undertake Your Cruise, and obtaining those documents;
 - ii. obtaining vaccinations;
 - iii. finding out about risks to Your health and safety in relation to Your proposed travel in consultation with Your doctor;
 - iv. obtaining adequate international travel insurance to cover You for Your Cruise; and
 - v. ensuring Your details are registered with Us and are up to date including phone number, email, address and emergency contact details.

- g) Travel advice can be obtained from various sources. In Australia, the Australian Department of Home Affairs (<https://www.homeaffairs.gov.au/>) and <https://www.smarttraveller.gov.au/>. In New Zealand, the New Zealand Immigration Service (<https://www.immigration.govt.nz/>) and <https://www.safetravel.govt.nz/>.

- h) Travel on a Round Trip Cruise from Australia will not be recognised by Australian Immigration to have left Australia and therefore the Cruise cannot be used to revalidate an Australian visa.

No Solicitation Permitted

- i) You must not solicit or promote any products and/or services to any other person while onboard Our ships without Our prior express approval. We reserve the right to exercise Our discretion to refuse or revoke Our permission at any time. If you breach this clause, the ‘Travel Restrictions and Rights of the Captain’ under clause 32 will apply.

4) Identification requirements

- a) Identification requirements vary by country and government agencies/departments can change those requirements including at short notice. It is Your responsibility to ensure You comply with the requirements in place at the destinations We plan to visit at the time of boarding Your Cruise. You are responsible for ensuring Your identification is in good condition and free from any damage. This includes but is not limited to tears, water damage, and any alterations that may render the identification invalid.

For domestic itineraries

- b) For domestic Cruises departing an Australian port that do not visit an international port, and for domestic Cruises departing a New Zealand port that do not visit an international port, a valid passport or government issued photo identification is required for all Adults. Accepted forms of government issued photo identification include a driver’s licence, proof of age cards and Government ID cards.

- c) For Australian domestic Cruises, a current Medicare card can be used for guests under 18 years of age. For New Zealand domestic Cruises, an original or certified copy of the Child’s birth certificate or a school pass with photo will be accepted for guests under 18 years of age.

For international itineraries

- d) For international itineraries which travel to either New Zealand or New Caledonia (1 country only), all guests are required to travel with a passport which must be valid for a minimum of three (3) months beyond the date of Your Cruise return and have sufficient blank pages for entry and exit stamps and visas for Your destination.
- e) For all other international itineraries, all guests are required to travel with a passport which must be valid for a minimum of six (6) months beyond the date of Your Cruise return and have sufficient blank pages for entry and exit stamps and visas for all destinations.

5) Other Services and Independent Contractors

- a) In addition to the Cruise, You may choose to book Other Services in connection with Your Cruise. This can cover things like:
 - i. flights;
 - ii. transfers;
 - iii. hotels;
 - iv. shore tours;
 - v. tickets to main events,(**'Other Services'**, and separately as **'Other Service'**).
- b) We may assist You in booking Other Services. Other Services are owned, supplied and/ or operated by independent contractors (**'Other Service providers'**). Other Service Providers are solely responsible for the information and Other Service offered, and their respective terms and conditions will apply.

6) Travel insurance

- a) We strongly recommend You purchase appropriate international travel insurance at the time You pay Your deposit. As health schemes like Australian Medicare and New Zealand Accident Compensation Corporation do not cover Your travel onboard, it is important that international travel insurance is purchased for all voyages (including domestic Australian and New Zealand itineraries which do not visit international ports). If You do not purchase international travel insurance You may not be able to recover charges, medical costs, repatriation and other expenses that may be incurred if things do not go according to plan, unless You are entitled to compensation or another remedy under the Consumer Laws or in accordance with clauses 22) or 23).
- b) Some countries included in Our Cruise itineraries have a mandatory requirement that guests hold international travel insurance that has cruise coverage. If this applies to Your Cruise itinerary, You must bring printed or digital proof of Your travel insurance policy when You check-in for Your Cruise or You will be denied boarding. You are responsible for all travel insurance requirements for Your Cruise.

7) Your Health

- a) You must be medically, physically and mentally fit for travel, and ensure that travel will not endanger Yourself or anyone else. If You require doctor's clearance to travel, it is Your responsibility to obtain that clearance. We may request that You provide evidence of such clearance to Us at any time.
- b) If You have a condition that may seriously affect Your health or safety or the health or safety of any other person onboard, We may refuse or cancel Your booking at Our discretion. We will exercise Our discretion giving reasonable consideration to Your circumstances and We will advise You of Our decision as soon as possible. Where Your booking is cancelled You may be entitled to a refund under clause 22) or Consumer Laws.
- c) Guests with restricted or limited mobility, and those with medical conditions must be self-sufficient or travel with a carer or someone who can assist with day-to-day activities. Our staff are unable to act as personal carers. Carers are at all times responsible for guests under their care.
- d) In the unlikely event of an emergency, it is important We have sufficient and specific support for guests who require additional assistance, and we have advance notice of the support required. You must advise Us if You need someone to guide and steady You on stairs as lifts may not be available in an emergency, even if You are travelling with someone else who can support You. Guests who are unable to get to their assembly stations independently for any reason must be pre-registered for assistance to ensure We can provide sufficient support. You must inform Us of any mobility or accessibility requirements You may have when making a booking or as soon as possible after the booking is made, by contacting Our Customer Service Team.

Communicable Diseases

- e) The transmission of Communicable Diseases can be facilitated by people interacting or in close/casual contact environments. Cruises involve the transportation of large numbers of people in an environment where they are likely to interact or come into close/casual contact with one another.
- f) You can be exposed to pathogens and Communicable Diseases at any time during Your Cruise (including onboard, in terminals, or while ashore). Exposure to pathogens and Communicable Diseases is an inherent risk of Your Cruise. While We have policies and procedures in place to reduce this risk, You acknowledge and accept that We cannot eliminate this risk and You accept this risk upon booking with Us.

8) Onboard Medical Centre

- a) Each ship has a medical centre that is staffed by qualified, licensed doctors and nurses (**medical staff**). Medical staff are available during routine clinic hours and 24 hours a day in the event of an emergency.
- b) All onboard medical centres are well equipped to handle most medical conditions that arise while onboard and are accredited to international healthcare quality standards. All of Our medical centres are only for medical needs arising onboard and cannot cater for treatments that You know You will require while on holiday. Further, medical care in the places We visit may be limited in comparison to Australian and New Zealand standards. It is Your responsibility to consider Your itinerary and Your medical needs before booking with Us.
- c) The medical centre is outside the scope of any health schemes like Australian Medicare and New Zealand Accident Compensation Corporation. The onboard medical centre is a private facility and as such consultations, treatments and medication are charged at private rates and must be paid by You before Your final disembarkation. You may be entitled to seek reimbursement of Your medical expenses from Your international travel insurer (if applicable).
- d) While the medical centres are equipped to handle many medical conditions that arise while onboard, there may be occasions where it becomes necessary to disembark or evacuate You or a guest to receive further essential medical treatment. To ensure guest safety, this decision will be made by medical staff and the Captain. If this occurs, You acknowledge and agree that all medical services, repatriation costs, transport/travel expenses, onshore accommodation expenses, onshore meals and the like are not included in Your Fare and must be paid by You.

9) Pregnant Guests

- a) We are unable to accept any guests who will have entered their 24th week of pregnancy or later at any time during the Cruise. If You are pregnant at the commencement of Your Cruise, You must obtain a letter from Your doctor prior to embarkation which confirms You are fit to travel and specifies Your estimated due date. This letter must be produced upon request.
- #### 10) Specific Needs
- a) We understand You may have specific needs to enable You to undertake Your Cruise in a safe, healthy, comfortable and enjoyable manner. Specific needs can cover things like:
 - i. using a medical mobility aid onboard such as a wheelchair or scooter;
 - ii. requiring wheelchair assistance at the cruise terminal or wheelchair accessible transfers;
 - iii. dietary requirements;
 - iv. requiring a baby cot/crib;
 - v. requiring assistive listening systems;
 - vi. requiring a carer, interpreter or other support person;
 - vii. bringing Your Assistance Animal onboard;
 - viii. administering medications via injection;
 - ix. bringing specialist medical equipment onboard;
 - x. refrigeration for medication.

- b) Without limiting clause (10)c) below, due to the inherent nature and risks of travel by sea, if You have specific needs in relation to Your Cruise, You must contact Our Customer Service Team before booking Your Cruise, or as soon as possible after booking, to confirm whether We can meet Your specific needs for Your chosen Cruise. We will make reasonable adjustments, but cannot guarantee We can meet Your specific needs. Please note that in order to meet Your specific needs, We may require You to purchase a specific category of stateroom.
- c) Guests who are bringing a wheelchair or mobility aid onboard must advise Us at the time of booking. You must provide Your own wheelchair or mobility aid and must ensure it can be stored inside Your stateroom. Limited areas of the ship may not be wheelchair accessible. Please note that some ports can only be accessed using the ship's tenders. Tender boats and tender ports are generally not accessible to guests who use a wheelchair or with significant mobility impairments.
- d) If You take medication on a regular basis or anticipate requiring certain medication during Your Cruise, You should pack an adequate supply to cover the planned itinerary and any potential delays. You must ensure that You take all medication with You upon disembarkation as any medication left behind will be disposed of.

11) Minimum Age to Travel

- a) Due to limited neo-natal facilities onboard and at the destinations We visit, the following minimum guest ages apply to Our Cruises:

1. Transocean crossings (Atlantic, Pacific, Indian, Antarctic, Arctic, etc.) and remote itineraries where there are more than two consecutive sea days. 2. Any other itinerary which may in the opinion of medical staff present a significant risk to infants between 6 and 12 months of age requiring emergency medical care. This includes World Cruises (excluding coastal segments), South America, Panama Canal, crossing the Tasman Sea (Australia-New Zealand), South Pacific Islands, including Hawaii-Tahiti (excluding fly cruising to French Polynesia with local cruising only).	12 months
All other itineraries	6 months
Escorted cruisetours	5 years

- b) To request an exemption for infants between 6 and 12 months, please contact Our Customer Service Team. Without limiting clause (32), in determining any exemption request, the relevant shoreside medial department will consider a number of factors which may include things like the infant's current health status, medical history, the potential for any foreseeable medical needs, the length of the Cruise, the proximity to onshore medical facilities and the ability of the ship's medical staff to provide emergency care to an infant if required. In making a request for exemption, You agree to provide all information reasonably requested by Us in order for Us to assess the request for exemption. This information will be treated in accordance with Our Privacy Policy.

12) Children

- a) For the safety and enjoyment of all onboard, there may be limits on the number of Children that can be carried within different age groups. We will advise You whether We are able to accommodate bookings for Children on the Cruise You have chosen. If We cannot accommodate Children on Your Cruise and You have already made a booking, We will notify You and offer a full refund for all guests on Your booking.

The following clauses apply depending from where Your Cruise departs or operates:

- b) Cruises departing from and returning to an Australian port, or departing from a port in Singapore:
For safety reasons, there must be at least one Adult occupying each stateroom. However, for families travelling together and with inter-connecting staterooms, Children may occupy an inter-connecting stateroom to their parent/Guardian on the condition that at least one Child in the stateroom is aged 16 years or older.
- c) Cruises departing from a Japanese port:
To ensure there is suitable supervision, there needs to be at least one guest in each stateroom **aged 20 years** or older. However, for families travelling together and with inter-connecting staterooms, Children may occupy an inter-connecting stateroom to their parent/Guardian on the condition that at least one Child in the stateroom is aged 16 years or older.
- d) Everywhere else
To ensure there is suitable supervision, there needs to be at least one guest in each stateroom **aged 21 years** or older. However, for families travelling together and with inter-connecting staterooms, Children may occupy an inter-connecting stateroom to their parent/Guardian on the condition that at least one Child in the stateroom is aged 16 years or older.

BOOKING

13) Your Fare

- a) All Cruise Fares include:
 - i) onboard accommodation;
 - ii) select onboard main meals at designated dining options;
 - iii) select onboard amenities, entertainment and activities; and
 - iv) taxes, fees and port expenses.

- b) We offer a variety of Fare types and each one is subject to different prices and conditions, including payment and cancellation conditions. From time to time, We may also offer promotional Fares with us, which will be subject to the terms and conditions specified at the time of booking.
- c) Children are charged the same Fare as Adults unless otherwise specified. Children's meals are included in the Fare, however baby food and formula are not included. Some amenities and entertainment are subject to age and height restrictions or may be unsuitable for guests with specific needs (see clause (10)).
- d) Additional charges may apply to some onboard entertainment, amenities, activities, and specialty restaurants. Also, a number of optional extras are available to purchase but are not included in the Fare. This may cover things like select onboard meals, beverages, Child minding services, some activities and entertainment, shore tours, shopping, Wi-Fi internet, laundry services, day spa services, fitness classes and additional dining options.

14) Your Booking

- a) A booking, and payments on a booking, must only be made by an Adult.
- b) When You or Your travel agent on Your behalf makes a booking and/or makes changes to a booking, You represent to Us that You have authority from all guests in Your booking.
- c) It is essential that all of Your booking details are correct and up to date. As soon as You receive Your booking confirmation, You must check that all details are correct. If any details are incorrect, please contact Us or Your travel agent.
- d) Please note every guest in Your booking will have access to the booking (excluding credit card details) via Cruise Personalizer and Princess MedallionClass App, and that any Adult named on Your booking can make changes to the booking.

Prices and Extras

- e) All prices are quoted in New Zealand dollars, unless otherwise specified. The onboard currency is either in AU Dollars or US Dollars and varies by ship and itinerary. In the event that a displayed price is incorrect, subject to any requirements under the Consumer Laws, We may retract the price and/or withdraw the Cruise from sale and refund any payments made at the incorrect price.
- f) Sometimes We will release promotional Fares. These can be offered and withdrawn at any time. If after booking You choose to change to one of Our promotional Fares, You may need to cancel Your existing booking and clause 17 will apply.

15) Payments

- a) Your booking is not secure until an initial deposit in cleared funds is received by Us. Your deposit and final payment due dates will be indicated on Your booking confirmation, which are subject to any Additional Terms that apply at the time You make Your booking. We will send You or Your travel agent a reminder email shortly before a payment is due. If You miss a payment due date, Your booking will be cancelled automatically and clause 17 will apply.

- b) A deposit is required for all guests on the Cruise. The amount of the deposit will be specified at the time of booking and set out in Your booking confirmation.

- c) Once a Future Cruise Deposit is applied to a booking, it is considered 'cash' and is subject to Our standard 'Cancellation and Refunds' Policy set out in clauses (16) to (23). This includes World Cruise bookings.

Final Payment

- d) The payment schedule for the remaining balance will be specified at the time of booking and set out in Your booking confirmation. Bookings and some promotional Fares made within the final payment period will require payment of the full Fare at the time of booking.

- e) When booking through a travel agent, they may have different payment conditions that will apply to Your booking. Please check with Your travel agent at the time of booking.

Waitlist bookings

- f) If Your requested cruise or stateroom category is unavailable, You can choose to create a 'waitlist booking'. This means that if Your requested cruise or stateroom category becomes available, You will be sent a 'waitlist match' via email. Once sent, You have until the date listed on the 'waitlist match' to accept the booking or it will automatically cancel. If accepted, Your booking will be subject these Conditions including but not limited to clauses 15 to 23 in these Conditions. There is no deposit required for guests who already have a booking and would like to waitlist for a different stateroom category on any Cruise. For a waitlist only booking, a deposit of \$200 per booking is required. If Your waitlist is accepted the waitlist deposit paid will contribute to Your booking deposit. If You do not accept the waitlist match, or a waitlist match does not become available, the waitlist deposit is fully refundable.

CHANGES OR CANCELLATIONS BY YOU

16) Changes by You

- a) Once You have made Your booking, please check Your invoice on Cruise Personalizer, or with Your Travel Agent to ensure the details are correct. Subject to clause 16(e), if You need to make changes to Your booking (spelling corrections or to replace a guest other than the first guest), We will not charge You administration fees. Please note however, that additional fees charged by Other Service Providers and airlines that we incur for any of Your changes will be payable by You.
- b) Please be aware that one original guest from the booking must always remain on the booking or the booking will be subject to the applicable cancellation charges set out in clause 17.
- c) If the cancelling guest was the only person that qualified the booking for a promotional Fare (eg: past guest Fare), additional and remaining guests will no longer be entitled to the promotional Fare including any applicable offers. The remaining guests may cancel the booking in accordance with clause 17, and charges may apply. If the remaining guests wish to proceed with the booking, the booking will revert to the market Fare available at the time the qualifying guest cancels and the remaining guests will need to pay the difference in cost, if any, between the promotional Fare and the market Fare. If a cancellation results in You becoming the sole occupant of a stateroom, You must pay the single person supplement.
- d) We are unable to accept name changes, new bookings or new guests on existing bookings within 48 hours of departure.
- e) If You make a booking through Your travel agent, You must contact Your travel agent to make changes to the booking.

17) Cancellation by You

- a) Should You need to cancel Your booking, You must notify Us as soon as possible. If You made a booking through Your travel agent, You must contact Your travel agent if You wish to cancel Your booking.

- b) Subject to any Additional Terms that apply to Your booking, and except where clauses 23 and 25(a) apply, when You cancel Your Cruise, the Cancellation Charges shown in the following table will apply. You may also be entitled to a refund under the Consumer Laws, and nothing in this clause affects that entitlement.

- c) Unless otherwise stated, Cancellation Charges are calculated based on the total amount payable to Us for Your booking, including taxes, fees and port expenses (**'Total Cost'**).
- d) Subject to Additional Terms, and notwithstanding the below tables, for certain promotional fares, the deposit is non-refundable.

- e) Unless specified otherwise, any 'second deposit' constitutes part of Your deposit and is subject to Our standard cancellation policy set out in clause 17)b)above.
- f) If You book through a travel agent or another third party they may have different cancellation and refund terms which apply to Your booking. Please ensure You check these at the time of booking.

18) How We process refunds

- a) For payments made through Your travel agent, refunds will be issued by Us back to Your travel agent. We are not liable for any failure of Your travel agent to remit a refund to You.
- b) For bookings made directly with Us, refunds will be processed back to the original method of payment. For Visa, MasterCard & American Express – refunds will be issued back to the card/s that was used to make payment. Where this is not possible, a bank transfer may be used via a third party provider.

CHANGES OR CANCELLATION BY US

19) When We may need to change or cancel Your booking

- a) Sometimes things can happen that may affect Your Cruise. This could include changes to Laws, weather or environmental conditions, mechanical difficulties, health or safety emergencies, civil unrest, industrial action or other unforeseen circumstances outside of Our control. In these circumstances, We may need to cancel or make changes to Your booking.
- b) We also may make changes or cancel Your booking due to circumstances that are within Our control for operational reasons.
- c) Changes made by Us may take the form of a:
 - i) change to the planned itinerary;
 - ii) charter of all or part of the ship; or
 - iii) change of the ship.

20) Notifying You of changes or cancellations

- We will take reasonable steps to notify You of any changes to or a cancellation of Your Cruise as soon as We can. If You booked Your Cruise directly with Us, We will contact You using the contact information You provided in Your booking. If You make a booking through Your travel agent, We will notify Your travel agent and Your travel agent is responsible for contacting You about any changes or cancellations.
- Sometimes changes are made at short notice prior to departure or during the Cruise. As Your itinerary is not guaranteed, please take this into account and We recommend that You do not make any important arrangements or meetings based on the planned itinerary.

21) Stateroom Changes and upgrades

- We might need to change Your stateroom allocation before or during Your Cruise for operational reasons including health and safety matters, when the number of people booked in the stateroom is less than the number of beds in the stateroom (for example, 2 people booked in a quad stateroom), or if You have selected a wheelchair accessible stateroom and do not require one.
- We may upgrade You to a higher stateroom grade at no extra charge and without consultation. If You have chosen Your booked stateroom for a particular reason or You are travelling as a group and do not want to be considered for an upgrade, please let Your travel agent or Our Customer Service Team know at the time of booking.
- At the time of booking, You may choose not to select a specific stateroom. In those circumstances, You will select and purchase a stateroom grade, however Your specific stateroom will be assigned at Our discretion in the category booked, or a higher priced category, at a later date (this is known as a **'Guarantee'**).

22) Your options if We cancel Your Cruise

- If We cancel Your Cruise for any reason prior to Your departure, We will offer You a full refund of Your Cruise Fare. We might also offer You the choice of alternative compensation instead of a refund, such as a Future Cruise Credit. You may also have additional rights (including under the Consumer Laws) where We have cancelled Your Cruise.

23) Your options if We make changes to Your Cruise

a) **Changes within Our control**

Where a significant change is made to Your itinerary prior to departure and this is due to a circumstance within Our control, for example for operational or commercial requirements, You will have the choice of:

- accepting the new itinerary;
- a Future Cruise Credit to the value of Your Fare paid; or
- cancelling the Cruise for a full refund of Your Fare paid.

For the purposes of this clause, **'significant change'** means a change to the city of departure or disembarkation, or to the majority (by number) of the other ports in Your itinerary.

You may also have additional rights (including under the Consumer Laws) where We have made a change to Your Cruise.

b) **Changes for reasons outside Our control**

It may be necessary to change the itinerary due to safety, compliance with Laws, weather or environmental conditions, to protect human life or health or other factors outside Our control. We will not provide any compensation in connection with the revised itinerary unless Consumer Laws require otherwise.

GETTING READY TO GO AND EMBARKATION

24) Prohibited and Restricted Items

- For health and safety reasons, each piece of luggage must not weigh more than 32kg. Other Service Providers including airlines may have other restrictions with which it is Your responsibility to ensure You comply.
- To ensure a safe and enjoyable holiday for all Our guests, items which may pose a risk to the health or safety of guests and crew, or which are illegal, must not be brought onboard Our ships including but not limited to: any item subject to a recall notice, irons, kettles, coffee machines, baby bottle warmers, candles, heating devices, illegal drugs, unapproved therapeutic goods, illicit substances, flammable liquids, weapons (including firearms, knives or blades of any kind), ammunition, animals (unless expressly permitted by Us), scooters (unless medically required and expressly permitted by Us), bicycles, skateboards, hoverboards (Flyboards or similar devices), remote control devices of any kind (such as drones), power boards with surge protection devices, cooking devices (such as hot plates), air/ BB/ pellet guns, communication scanners, wide-band receivers and satellite phones. Further, You must not carry onboard Our ships any item which is prohibited by a local Law. Please refer to our website for additional information.
- On the day of embarkation, guests are permitted to bring one 750ml (no larger) bottle of wine or champagne onboard per voyage, which will not be subject to a corkage fee if consumed in Your stateroom. Additional wine or champagne bottles are welcome, but will incur a corkage fee each, irrespective of where they are intended to be consumed. Corkage fees are listed on princess.com and are subject to change from time to time. Corkage will be charged in the operating currency on the ship. Liquor, spirits, or beers are not permitted. Any beverages purchased during the cruise at any port of call will be collected at the gangway for safekeeping and will be delivered to Your stateroom on the last day of the cruise. Princess Cruises® is not responsible for any alcoholic beverages confiscated by local security staff. These items are not eligible for monetary refund or replacement.
- All luggage (including hand and check-in) will be x-rayed at embarkation. We may refuse to carry You or Your luggage if You refuse to consent to Your luggage being x-rayed.
- You may be required to undergo a body search. We may refuse to carry You if You refuse to consent to a body search.
- Any prohibited items or items which may pose a quarantine or safety risk found in hand or checked-in luggage or on You will be confiscated and, if appropriate, made available for collection by You at the end of the Cruise. If the confiscated item is not collected at the end of the Cruise, You must contact Us within three (3) days of disembarking to claim the item. If You do not contact Us within this time, Your item may be destroyed without further notice to You.
- We can deny boarding to, or disembark, any person in possession of any weapons or illicit substances. We may also confiscate these items and hand them over to Law enforcement agencies.
- For security purposes, prior to embarkation, We require a security photograph of every guest. Face coverings may be required to be temporarily removed for security or identification purposes.

- Please make sure that all valuable and important items, such as jewellery, medicines, fragile items, and camera/computer/electrical equipment are carried in Your hand luggage and not packed in Your main luggage/suitcase or left unsecured in Your stateroom or elsewhere onboard ship. Once onboard, all valuables and important items should be stored in Your in-stateroom safe.
- In the event You lose any items onboard, please notify Guest Services immediately. If You have already disembarked please contact Our Guest Services team. Due to hygiene reasons, any unclaimed items that are considered in Our discretion unhygienic will be destroyed at the end of the Cruise. All other items must be claimed within three (3) days of disembarking Your Cruise by contacting Our Guest Services team. You are responsible for Our costs incurred in returning lost items to You, such as postage fees.

25) Security Cameras and Recordings

- For the health, safety and security of Our guests and crew, We use Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) surveillance (which may include facial recognition technology) to monitor and record public areas onboard all Our ships. In addition, shipboard crew may use body mounted cameras (video footage and audio recording) for the health, safety and security of Our guests and crew, and you agree to being recorded via video footage and audio by body-mounted security cameras for this purpose. The footage and any accompanying audio recording are confidential and are not available for viewing except by authorised persons, unless required or permitted by Law.

ONBOARD

26) Shipboard Environments

- There are some inherent features of travel by cruise ship which You should be prepared for. Some noises, vibrations and smells are associated with the normal operation of the ship. Maintenance may occur in certain areas of the ship while You are onboard which may affect access to these areas. Weather or environmental conditions or other events may also require Us to restrict access to certain areas of the ship for safety reasons.
- Movement in all directions is an inherent feature of travel by cruise ship. Some guests may experience motion sickness, nausea and/or vertigo as a result of the motion of the cruise ship. Unsecured or loose items can also move unexpectedly as a result of the motion and cause damage.

27) Onboard Purchases

- All Princess Cruises' ships operate on a 'cashless' system. When You become OceanReady® using the MedallionClass™ App, You will be asked to add a credit or debit card (Visa, Mastercard or Amex) which will be associated with Your wearable Medallion (the **"Medallion"**). The Medallion is what You will use onboard for all Your onboard purchases. As an alternative to using a credit or debit card, You can add funds to Your Medallion using cash.
- Where You do use a credit or debit card, We will obtain pre-authorisations from Your bank for the amounts spent on each day of Your Cruise in the ship's operating currency. These amounts are not actual charges, although they may appear like a charge on Your bank account or statement, they are holds to ensure You have sufficient funds available to settle Your account. Please be aware that while they are not actual charges, the pre-authorisations will be deducted from Your available bank account/credit card balance.
- At the end of Your Cruise, We will release all holds and charge Your nominated card a lump sum equal to Your total onboard expenditure throughout the Cruise. Please note that while We release all holds at the end of the Cruise, Your individual bank's terms and conditions apply and some banks can take up to 30 days to release the held funds back to You. As such, please ensure You have sufficient funds available in Your account to cover any bank hold(s) as well as Your final charge. We cannot be held responsible for any bank-imposed charges including if Your account is overdrawn. If You experience any delay having the held funds released back to You, You should contact Your bank.
- All onboard accounts must be settled in full before You leave the ship at the end of Your cruise. Should You fail to settle Your onboard account before disembarking the ship, We reserve the right cancel any existing or future bookings You may have with Us (and Our affiliate brands) and retain the outstanding sums from any refund due to You, without prejudice to any other remedies We may have under these Conditions or by Law.

Service Fees

- Service fees apply to all credit card transactions. For pre-Cruise transactions, the service fee for Visa credit and MasterCard credit transactions is 1.1%. For American Express the service fee is 2.75%. There is no service fee for debit card payments. For all credit card transactions onboard Your Cruise, unless otherwise advised, the service fee will be 1.1%. This fee will be charged once only at the end of the cruise. Service fees are subject to change and will be advised onboard. We recommend that You check with Your card issuer in advance of making any payments to confirm whether transactions on Your card attract a foreign processing fee.
- 28) Travelling with Children**
 - Parents and/or Guardians are at all times responsible for their Children (or Children in their care), who must be supervised at all times.
 - If a Child displays behaviour that may reasonably be perceived by Us/the crew to be dangerous, disruptive, unsafe or the like, the 'Travel Restrictions and Rights of the Captain' under clause 32 will be applied to both parent/Guardian and Child.
 - Some areas, amenities (including pools and spas) and entertainment are designated as 'Adults only'. Parents/Guardians are responsible for ensuring Children do not attend any restricted areas and activities onboard.
 - Children must be toilet trained and under their parent's/Guardian's supervision while using onboard pools, spas, waterpark and waterslides. Children wearing nappies must not enter any onboard pools, spas, waterpark or waterslides.
 - Prams and strollers must be collapsible and capable of being stored in Your cabin.
 - You acknowledge that if You are travelling with a Child of whom You are not the parent or legal Guardian, You are required to notify Us and complete the 'Consent Form for Minors Travelling with a Responsible Adult' executed by the Child's parent or legal Guardian. You must carry this form with You at all times during Your Cruise. You may be asked to make decisions relating to matters such as that Child's safety, health and dietary requirements, medical treatment and decisions relating to disciplinary matters.
 - Parents/Guardians must not disembark the ship without their Children (or Children in their care) unless they have pre-arranged for an Adult or the Kids Club to supervise their Child while they are not onboard.
- Youth & Teen centres**
 - We offer Kids and Youth & Teen centres onboard each ship for Children aged between 2 and 17 years of age. The Youth & Teen Centres are included in the Cruise Fare. Availability in the Youth & Teen Centres and use of the facilities are limited and provided on a first-come-first-served basis.

- Children under three (3) years of age are welcome to use the Youth & Teen centre facilities under the direct supervision of their parent/legal Guardian. To attend the Youth & Teen centres without a parent/legal Guardian, Children need to be three (3) years of age or over and toilet trained.
- Use of Youth & Teen centres requires daily registration and entry is on a first-come-first-served basis as places are limited. Group Child minding for Children three (3) to 12 years is available between 10pm and 1am only, for a fee.
- At all times We reserve the right to exercise Our discretion and refuse participation in the Kids and Youth centres or access to the Kids and Youth centre's facilities.

29) Alcohol & Gambling

- We are committed to the responsible service of alcohol and responsible gambling. The following minimum ages apply for guests to purchase, possess or consume alcohol onboard:

Government issued photo identification may be requested.

- There may be times when We consider it appropriate, in accordance with the Our Responsible Service of Alcohol Policy or the Rights of the Captain, to refuse the service of alcohol to a guest. In these circumstances, any access to onboard gambling activities will be disengaged. Also, no refund or compensation will be paid including for any beverage packages that apply.
- The minimum age for gambling on Our ships is 18 years old.
- All drinks packages that include alcohol are limited to 15 alcoholic beverages per 24-hour period (6am to 6am) and service is always subject to Our Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSA) Policy. Alcoholic beverages requested above this limit are charged at regular menu prices. Non-alcoholic beverages have no daily limit.
- Guests who purchase alcohol at any port of call or at onboard shops will have their alcohol stored by Us and delivered to their room on the date of disembarkation. You acknowledge that We may inspect beverages which We reasonably suspect to be containing alcohol.
- Violations to the alcohol policy may result in You being denied from being served alcohol onboard.
- There may be times when We consider it appropriate, in accordance with Our policies or the Rights of the Captain, to refuse a guest access to Our onboard gambling activities.
- The use of any recording or camera technology by guests in the casino is prohibited.

30) Smoking and Vaping

- The purchase, possession, or consumption of smoking products, including but not limited to tobacco, electronic cigarettes (e-cigarettes), vaporizers (vapes), and herbal cigarettes, by guests on board is strictly regulated. The minimum age Guests must meet for purchase, possession or consumption of same is 18 years.
- Except where specified by Us, smoking and vaping is not permitted indoors on any of Our ships. This includes in staterooms and on private balconies. For those who smoke, there are designated outdoor areas where smoking is permitted and this information will be communicated to You onboard. Tobacco, e-cigarettes and the like must only be used in the designated smoking areas onboard.
- Violations to the onboard smoking policy may result in a cleaning fee of up to USD\$250 for each occurrence, which will be charged to Your onboard account.

31) Additional Cleaning

- You must not cause wilful or neglectful damage while onboard the Cruise. You must reimburse Us for any damage You cause. Also, violations of this policy which require additional cleaning will result in a fee of up to USD\$250 for each occurrence, which will be charged to Your onboard account.

32) Travel restrictions and rights of the Captain

- During the Cruise, the Captain will exercise complete control over the ship and take such actions as they think necessary to preserve the safety and integrity of the ship and the comfort, health, safety, enjoyment and general wellbeing of the guests and crew.
- You are at all times responsible for ensuring that no travel restrictions apply to You and any Children in Your care or custody.
- If police or any other authority in any jurisdiction notify Us of, or We otherwise become aware of, any matter that reasonably causes Us to believe Your presence onboard might present a risk to Your health, safety, or any other person's onboard, We, and/or the Captain, may take any action reasonably necessary in response to the matter, including:
 - deny You boarding;
 - disembark You from the ship;
 - restrain or confine You onboard;
 - remove You from a particular stateroom or area onboard the ship;
 - search You, Your luggage and/or Your stateroom;
 - administer medication to You including use of sedatives (via the onboard doctor or nurse);
 - hand You and/or Your luggage over to local authorities; and/or
 - refuse or cancel any bookings from You;
 - Require You to take preventative, protective or remedial action; and/or
 - Require You to undertake medical testing.
- In such cases, We are not responsible for any expenses including Your return home. In addition, You will not be entitled to any refunds or compensation from Us unless required by the Consumer Laws.

PORTS OF CALL

33) Ports of Call

- Guests may choose to go ashore at a port of call. In the event that You go ashore, You acknowledge and agree that You do so at Your own risk. You are responsible for familiarising Yourself with, and adhering to, the local Laws, regulations and customs.

Additionally, We take no responsibility for any injury, death, loss and/or damage that occurs while You are not onboard the ship. Food must not be taken off the ship at any port of call as it can result in penalties.

DISEMBARKING

34) Leaving the Cruise early or late returning to the ship

- If You depart the ship at a port of call, You must ensure that You return to the ship prior to the cut-off time nominated by Us. Re-embarkation deadlines apply and may be strictly enforced.
- If You are required, or choose, to leave the Cruise for any reason (unless caused by Our negligence or failure to provide services with due care and skill and that are reasonably fit for purpose), We are not responsible for any expenses, including Your return home. This also applies if You do not return to the ship in time for sailing after a port visit. Subsequent boarding is not guaranteed and may be denied. You will not be entitled to any refunds or compensation from Us unless the Consumer Laws provide otherwise.
- It is important to be aware that it will not always be possible to leave a Cruise early, even when on an Australian domestic itinerary. Some Australian ports have strict border and quarantine restrictions which prevent cruise ship guests from discontinuing the Cruise in that port, even if they are an Australian passport holder. Many international ports also have strict border restrictions and visa requirements. For cruises departing in the United States, the *Passenger Vessel Services Act ("PVSA")* prohibits the transportation of passengers between two different US ports. You must not, in breach of the PVSA, embark and disembark at different US ports or otherwise purposefully cause a violation of the PVSA. Breaches of this clause will be subject to clause 37(c).

35) Lost luggage and personal belongings

- You are at all times responsible for Your belongings. Also, it is Your responsibility to remove all of Your belongings from the stateroom prior to disembarking the ship.
- While We will provide reasonable assistance in locating any items left onboard, We are not responsible for any items misplaced, lost or left behind by You.
- Once You disembark the ship, You must collect Your checked luggage as soon as it is available for collection. Due to hygiene reasons, any unclaimed items that are considered in Our discretion unhygienic will be destroyed at the end of the Cruise. All other items must be claimed within three (3) days of disembarking Your Cruise by contacting Our Guest Services team. You are responsible for Our costs incurred in returning lost items to You, such as postage fees. If You pick up the wrong luggage, it is Your responsibility to immediately return the luggage to Us and at Your own expense.

OUR VALUES

36) Princess Local Partnership Program

- We are committed to supporting communities in the destinations We visit. As part of Our Princess Local Partnership Program, an \$2 donation in the onboard currency will be automatically added to the onboard account for each guest aged 18 years or over on all New Zealand itineraries (including Australia & New Zealand combined itineraries). The donation will be used towards community based initiatives in the destinations We visit. This is an optional donation and You may remove it from Your onboard account before embarkation or onboard or at the Guest Services Desk before You disembark or obtain a refund after Your Cruise by contacting Our Customer Service Team. 37) Environmental Policy

Any wilful or negligent act of discharging or releasing any unauthorised item onboard, without the express permission of the ship's staff, may result in a \$500 charge (charged in the operating currency of the ship), per violation, posted to Your onboard account.
 - Additionally, You may be charged the reimbursement cost of any unauthorised property belonging to Us that You discharge or release overboard. Subject to applicable Laws, You agree to indemnify Us for any loss caused by Your wilful or negligent conduct in contravention of this clause.
 - You may be disembarked for violations of Our Environmental Policy and You will be responsible for all financial charges and expenses to return home. No refund of Your unused Cruise Fare will be provided. Additionally, You may be prohibited from sailing with Us and Our affiliate brands in the future.

LIMITATION AND EXCLUSION OF OUR LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY BY YOU

38) Limitation of Liability

- Nothing in these Conditions alters any rights given to You under Law (including Consumer Laws) that We cannot lawfully exclude or limit.
- Other than as specified in Your Contract with Us or provided by applicable Laws (including Consumer Laws), We exclude all liability in relation to or in connection with Your Cruise unless caused by Our negligence or failure to provide services with due care and skill or that are reasonably fit for purpose.

You agree to Indemnify Us
- To the maximum extent permitted by Law, You will indemnify Us in relation to all claims, loss, damages, liability, expenses, fines, penalties or costs We incur or suffer which is caused, or contributed to (to the extent of that contribution), by Your breach of Your Contract with Us. However, You are not required to indemnify Us in respect of any amount which arises from any mistake, fraud, negligence or reckless conduct by Us.

Limitation of liability for Recreational Services

- Except for liability for significant personal injury caused by Reckless Conduct by Us or Our personnel, servants or agents, where We provide Recreational Services, We exclude liability for all Excluded Recreational Liabilities in connection with Our failure to comply with any consumer guarantees applying under the CCA.
 - In this clause:
 - Reckless Conduct** has the meaning set out in section 139A(5) of the CCA.
 - Excluded Recreational Liabilities** means liabilities described in section 139(3) of the CCA which, without limitation, includes liability for death, physical or mental injury, or contraction, aggravation or acceleration of any disease; and
 - Recreational Services** has the meaning set out in section 139A(2) of the CCA.

Limitation of Liability for Independent Contractors

- f) Other than as provided by applicable Laws (including Consumer Laws), We exclude all liability in relation to and in connection with any good and/or service provided by an independent contractor in relation to or in connection with Your Cruise (including but not limited to all Other Services).

Limitation of Liability for Lost or Damaged Luggage or Personal Belongings

- g) To the extent Consumer Laws and other Laws permit Us to exclude Our liability, We will not be liable for loss of, damage to, or theft of any luggage, personal items or other belongings, unless caused by Our negligence or failure to provide services with due care and skill or that are reasonably fit for purpose.

Contributory Negligence

- h) You agree that Our liability will be reduced in proportion to any negligence or fault on Your part.

Notification of Incidents, Complaints or Claims

- i) You agree to use all reasonable efforts to report any and all incidents, complaints, claims onboard or otherwise and bring the matter to Our attention as soon as possible. You acknowledge that any delay or failure to bring any matter to Our attention whilst onboard may impact Our ability to investigate and verify the matter.

39) Choice of Law and jurisdiction

- a) Your Contract with Us is governed by the Laws in force in New South Wales. You agree that any claim and/or action You bring against Us will be brought in Australia and will be subject to New South Wales' Law. If You have a claim and/or action Us, You agree only to bring an action against Carnival Plc trading as Princess Cruises and not any of Our related bodies corporate as defined in the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth).

40) Compliance with Trade Sanctions

- a) You acknowledge and agree that at any time, if We reasonably believe that Your participation in the Cruise may expose Us to breach of Trade Sanctions or expose Us to legal liability in relation to Trade Sanctions, We have the right to cancel Your Contract without liability or any obligation to refund of any portion of Your Fare.

- b) By entering into Your Contract, You are deemed to represent to Us that You are not subject to any Trade Sanctions or listed on any lists of sanctioned persons for Trade Sanctions, and You are not entering into Your Contract on behalf of or for the benefit of anyone who is. You agree that You will tell Us as soon as practicable if this changes.

41) Interpretation

- a) All provisions, limitations, exemptions, rights and conditions given to Us by these Conditions, including the right to rely on the exclusive jurisdiction clause, are extended to all of Our employees, agents, direct or indirect subcontractors (including sub-subcontractors, the Carrier and the Carrier's employees, agents, direct or indirect subcontractors) and to any other party employed by or on behalf of Us, or whose services and/or equipment have been used in order to perform Your Contract with Us (the **Protected Entity**). We are acting as agent or trustee for all members of the Protected Entity. The Protected Entity does not include Other Service providers referred to in clause 5.

- b) In these Conditions, headings are for ease of reference only and do not affect the interpretation or meaning of these Conditions.

42) Severability

- a) Your Contract with Us must, so far as possible, be interpreted and construed so as not to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, but if a provision, on its true interpretation or construction is held to be illegal, invalid or unenforceable:
- that provision must so far as possible, be read down to the extent necessary to ensure that it is not illegal, invalid or unenforceable and as reasonable in all the circumstances so as to give it a valid operation; or
 - if the provision or part of it cannot effectively be read down, that provision or part of it will be deemed to be void and severable and the remaining provisions of Your Contract with Us will not in any way be affected or impaired and will continue notwithstanding that illegality, invalidity or unenforceability.

MedallionClass

"Fare" means the amount paid by, or payable by, You to Us for Your Cruise.

"Future Cruise Credit" means a credit that you can use for your next Princess cruise. Future Cruise Credits are subject to Additional Terms notified to You at the time of issuance.

"Guardian" includes the following:

- a person appointed in a guardianship order as a guardian under Law; or
- a person vested with authority over the other person by virtue of Power of Attorney;
- an Adult who has legal parental responsibility of the Child/Children in question; or
- Adults specified in a completed 'Minors travelling with a Responsible Adult' form.
