Port Details

Pier 91 is located at the north end of Seattle’s downtown waterfront, just minutes from the city’s retail core and historic Pike Place Market. Seattle-Tacoma International Airport is located 17 miles south of Pier 91 – transit time is approximately 40 minutes.

Luggage Handling

Prior to arriving at the pier, please ensure that all Princess luggage tags are attached (additional Princess luggage tags may be obtained at the pier). This is in addition to your personal identification tag.

Curbside porters are available at the pier to take luggage to the vessel for delivery by shipboard personnel to your stateroom. It is customary to tip porters for their service. Please be advised that curbside porters are not employees of Princess Cruises. You are responsible for your belongings at all times. For security reasons, we remind you to keep your hand luggage, including laptops, cameras, any medications, all travel documentation (passports, visas, etc.) and other valuables in your possession at all times.

Parking

- Lot is located 5 minutes from the terminal and offers complimentary shuttle service with luggage handling.
- Located at 2001 West Garfield St., Lot D, Seattle, WA 98119.
- Fee is \$26 per day for automobiles and is subject to change without notice.

- Oversize/recreational vehicles are welcome – please refer to the Republic Parking website for applicable fees.
- Patrolled 24/7 by security.

Cell Phone Waiting Lot

A complimentary cell phone waiting lot is available for guests being picked up by private vehicles operated by friends, family, limo services, etc. Please advise private vehicles to proceed to the cell phone waiting lot, located approximately ¼ mile from the terminal building. You should call your party after you have claimed your luggage, processed through U.S. immigration, and have exited the building. The location of the cell phone waiting lot is depicted on the terminal map on page 2 of this document.

Directions

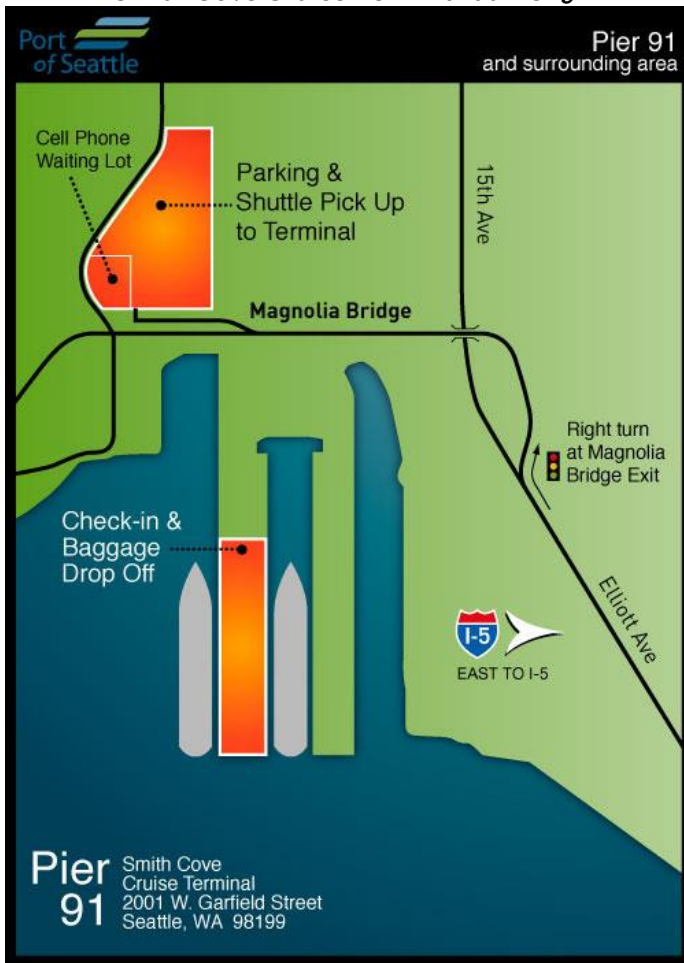
From I-5 South:

1. Head south on I-5 and follow the signs to the Mercer Street Exit
2. Take Mercer Street Exit
3. Continue on Mercer Street for 1.6 miles.
4. Turn right onto Elliott Ave W, follow signage for Magnolia Bridge
5. Turn right at 14th Ave West (signal light intersection)
6. Stay to the right and follow ramp joining the Magnolia Bridge (West Garfield Street)
7. Exit right. Follow signs to "Smith Cove Park" and Cruise Terminal
8. Turn right at bottom of ramp and follow signs for cruise terminal parking or cruise terminal

From I-5 North:

1. Head North on I-5 and follow the signs to the Mercer Street Exit
2. Take Mercer Street Exit
3. Continue on Mercer Street for 1.6 miles.
4. Turn right onto Elliott Ave W, follow signage for Magnolia Bridge
5. Turn right at 14th Ave West (signal light intersection)
6. Stay to the right and follow ramp joining the Magnolia Bridge (West Garfield Street)
7. Exit right. Follow signs to "Smith Cove Park" and Cruise Terminal
8. Turn right at bottom of ramp and follow signs for cruise terminal parking or cruise terminal
