





THE MIGHTY MĀORI








SURF'S UP!


TOASTING TASMANIA

TALES OF THIEVES & ROGUES

Most are familiar with Australia's history as a penal colony for the United Kingdom. One of the most famous penitentiaries was Port Arthur in Tasmania, whose beautiful Victorian buildings are part of a UNESCO World Heritage Site dedicated to Australia's convict sites. Because many of the crimes were relatively insignificant, feelings have changed about the country's penal history. Today, many Australians consider it a badge of honor to have convict heritage.



TRUE LIFE MYSTERY



INTO THE DEEP BLUE

Located on the coast of Vanuatu a short distance from the port of Luganville is the Nanda Blue Hole, one of a number of unique "blue hole" phenomena around the world. This famous swimming hole, noted for the electric blue color of its waters, was formed by springs of fresh water percolating up from deep beneath the limestone. The site also offers a bar, picnic area and boardwalk.
