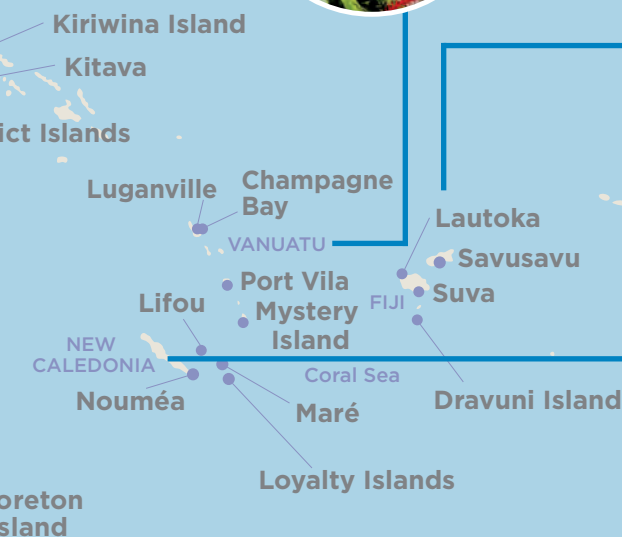
Fiji
