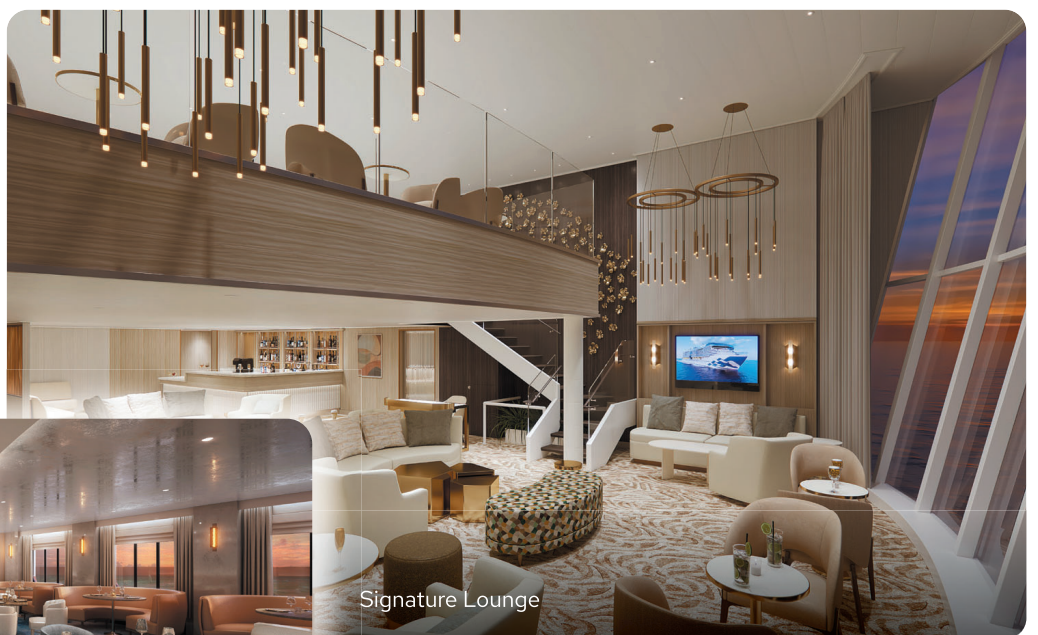

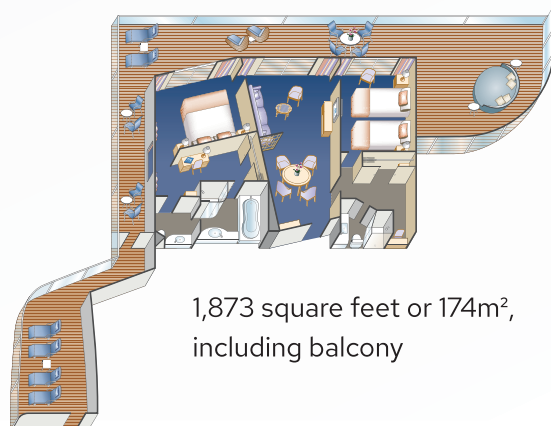

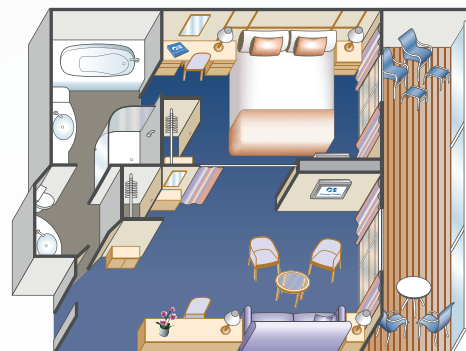

PRINCESS UPGRADE
