



PRINCESS **UPGRADE**

Skip the fear of missing out and make a bid for an upgraded stateroom with the Princess Upgrade program. Princess Upgrade allows you the opportunity to vie for an upgrade to your stateroom, just like bidding to upgrade an airline seat.
