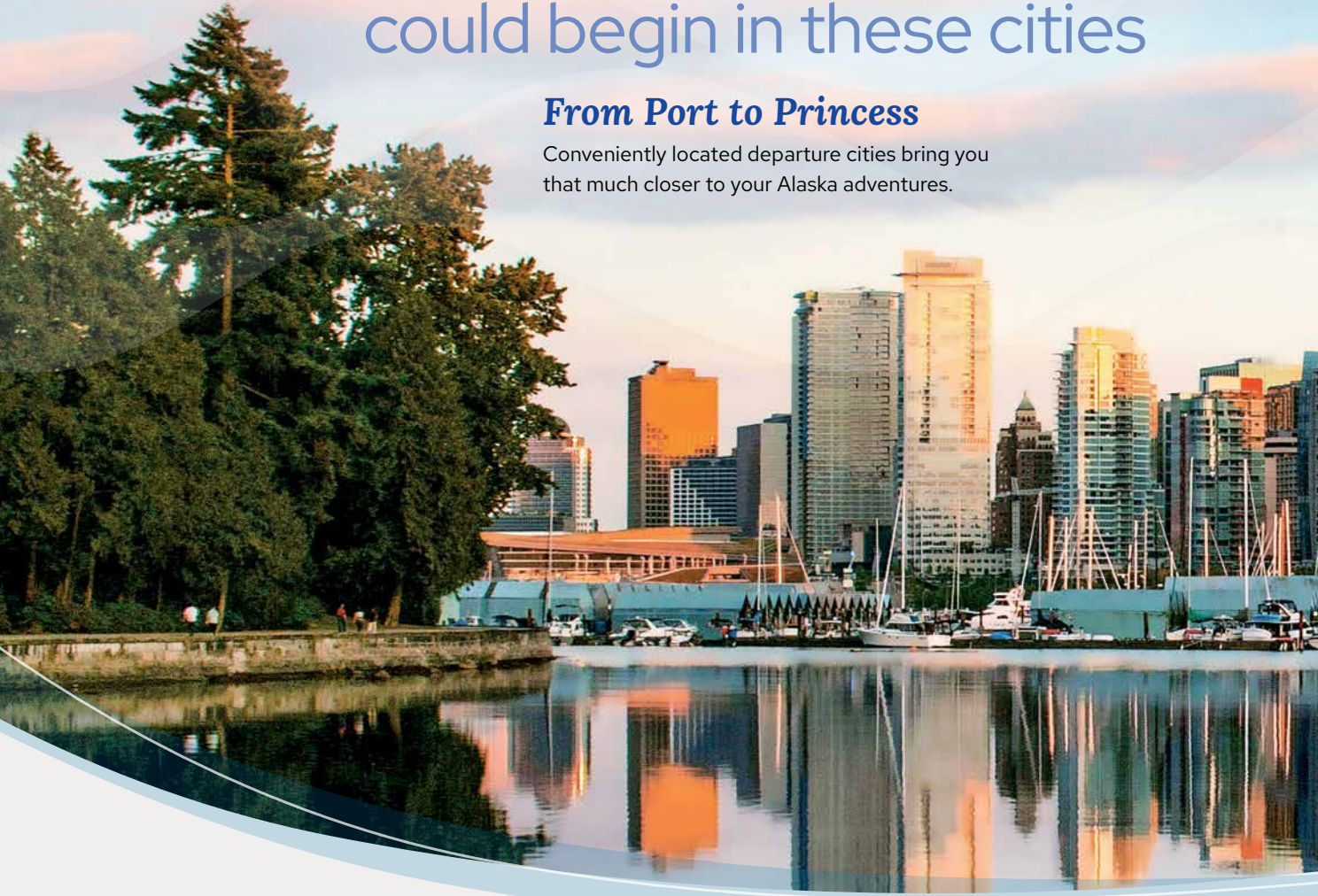

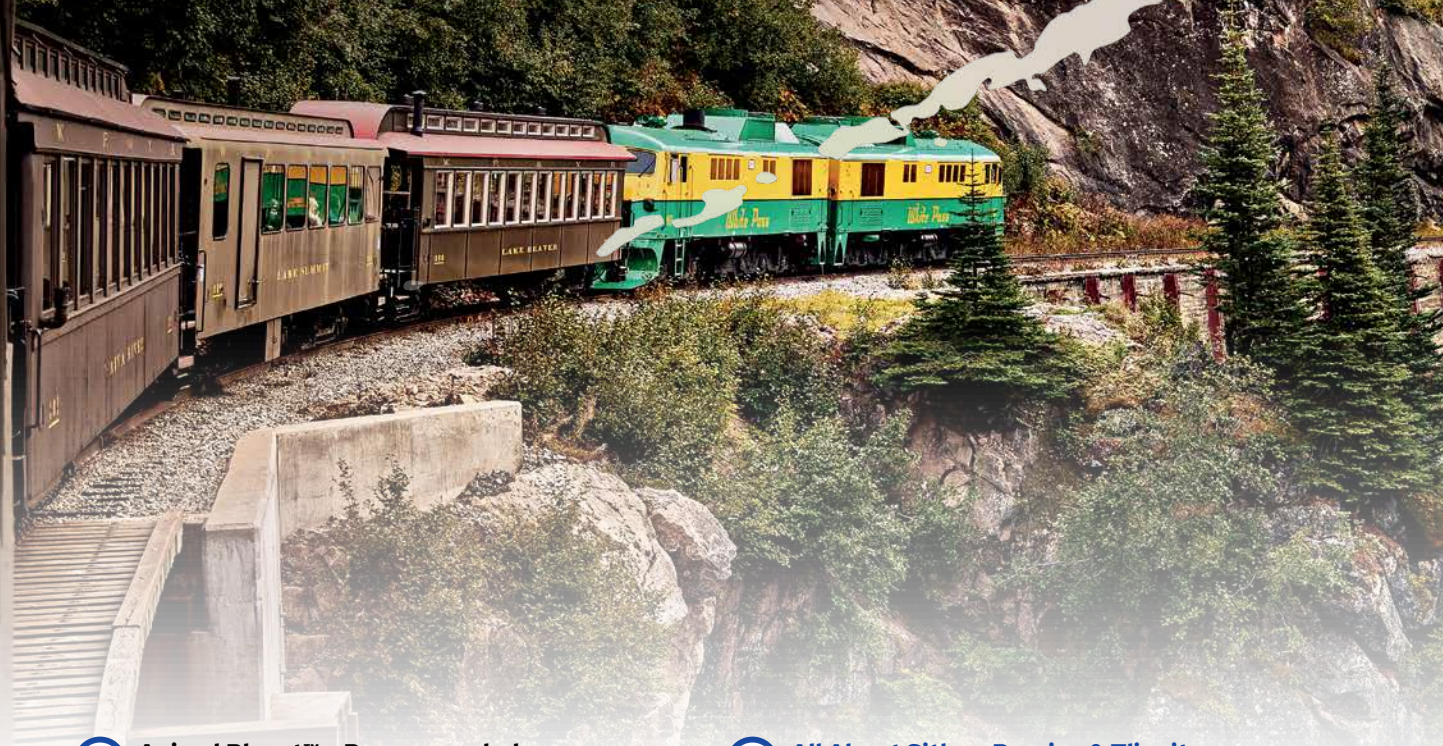

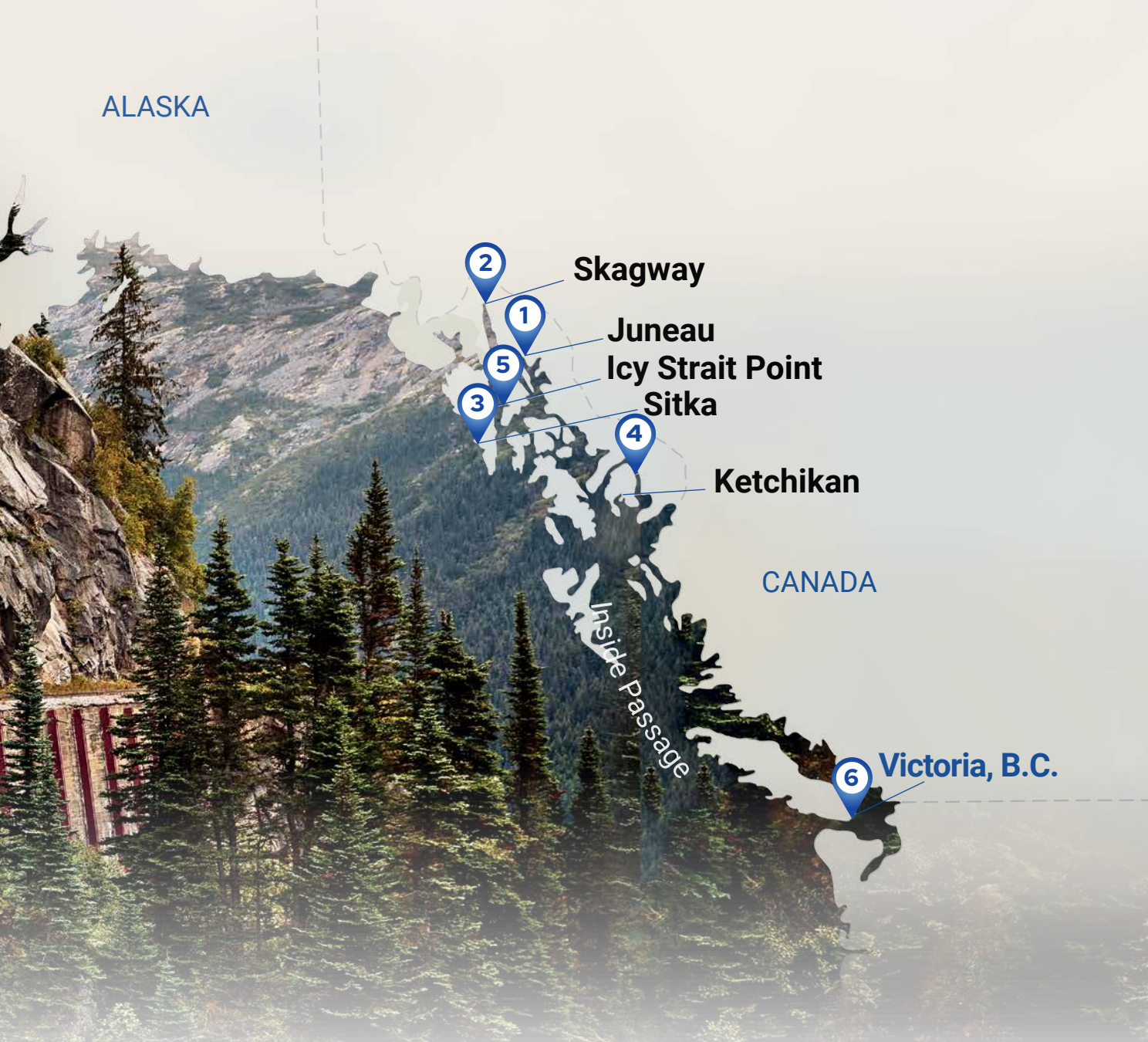

Glacier Bay National Park

It's the jewel of the Inside Passage – and that's saying a lot. Float alongside miles-long islands of ice, including Margerie Glacier, and watch sea otters and humpback whales playing in the waters below. Because you can't explore all 3.3 million acres on your cruise, Princess brings this UNESCO World Heritage Site to you, welcoming rangers on board to share their insider knowledge.

Endicott Arm & Dawes Glacier

Fjords, glaciers and forests, oh my! Keep your eyes peeled for bears and harbor seals on the shores, as well as waterfalls and snow-capped peaks in the distance, as your ship weaves through Endicott Arm's narrow waterway. At the head of the fjord, the grand finale comes into view – as Dawes Glacier dramatically sends chunks of ice into the waters below.

Hubbard Glacier

North America’s largest tidewater glacier is bigger (and faster) than you might think. A whopping 76 miles long and seven miles wide, the “Galloping Glacier” moves at such a pace that it regularly drops icebergs the size of 10-story buildings into the water. Keep your camera ready to capture the splash!

View from this cruise: Voyage of the Glaciers (Southbound)

College Fjord

Sail by Harvard, Vassar and Yale – glaciers, that is. Named after Ivy League and Seven Sisters schools, College Fjord is the world’s largest collection of tidewater glaciers. They crack, tumble and make thunderous splashes into Prince William Sound. With snowy mountains in the distance and 40-ton humpback whales regularly feeding in the fjord below, it’s known as one of the world’s most breathtaking destinations.

Stretching all the way from Washington's Puget Sound and into Southeast Alaska, the Inside Passage has more than 1,000 islands, fjords and quiet bays. The oceanview stateroom includes all our standard Princess amenities plus a broad picture window to bring in light and views.



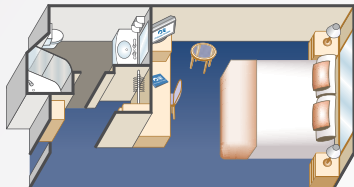

Wheelchair-Accessible Staterooms

Our fully accessible staterooms are designed for use by guests with highly limited or no mobility who require regular use of a mobility device, and provide accessible elements including turning space, accessible routes throughout the cabin, and accessible bathrooms. Staterooms range from approximately 237 to 624 square feet based on stateroom category.



Note: Floor plans, amenities, stateroom images and diagrams represent typical arrangements and may vary by ship. Certain stateroom categories may vary in size and configuration by ship. Square footage varies based on stateroom category and deck location. Stateroom views are considered unobstructed unless noted otherwise. Some categories have portholes versus picture windows. Some staterooms are partially to fully obstructed, as shown on deck plans. Obstructions do not include certain nautical items like handrails, dividers or ship hardware. For balcony staterooms, the view is determined from the perspective of the balcony railing. Balconies may have either solid steel or glass railings. Upper berth and bed ladder capacities are 250 lbs. Staterooms that can accommodate rollaways have two lower berths and one upper berth, and the staterooms can accommodate a fourth berth as a rollaway bed upon request at time of reservation. There are a limited number of rollaway beds per ship, per voyage. Use of rollaway beds restricts cabin space.
